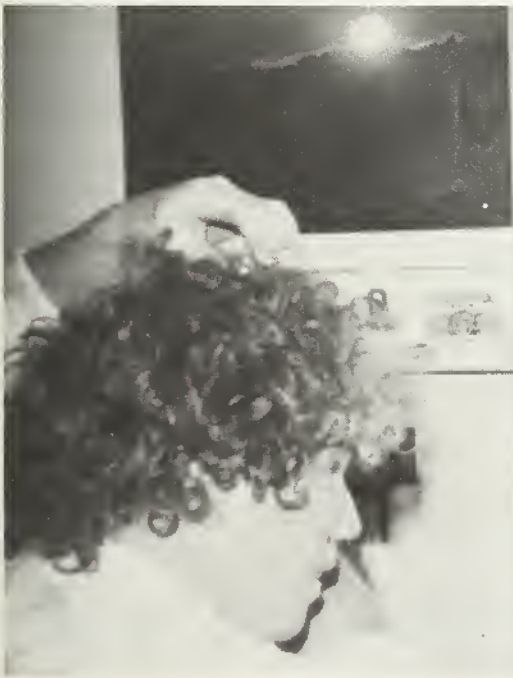
Ah, sweet freedom . . .

. but always, let me be me, and — let me be free . . .





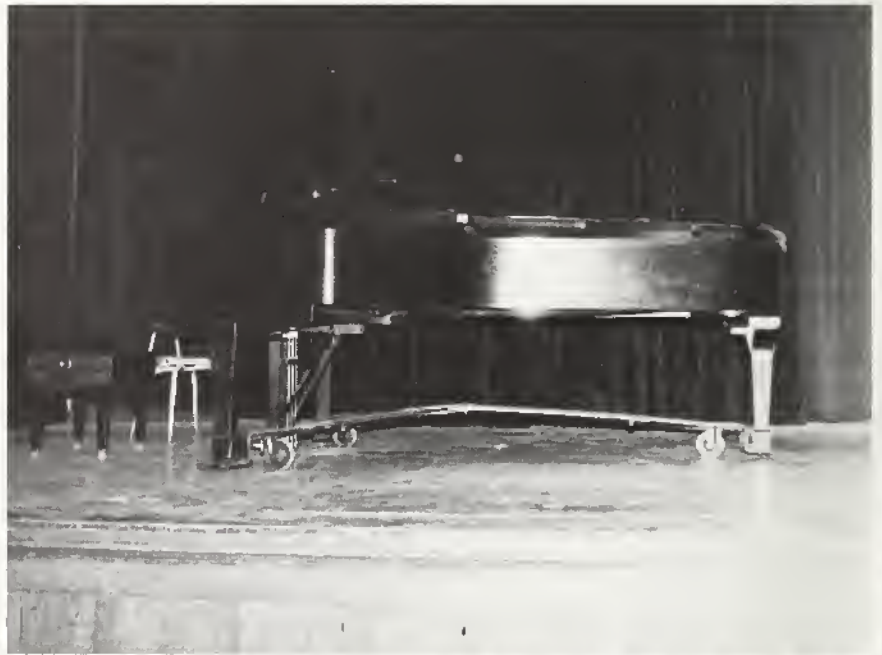
Let me be free . . .

Women's Track —

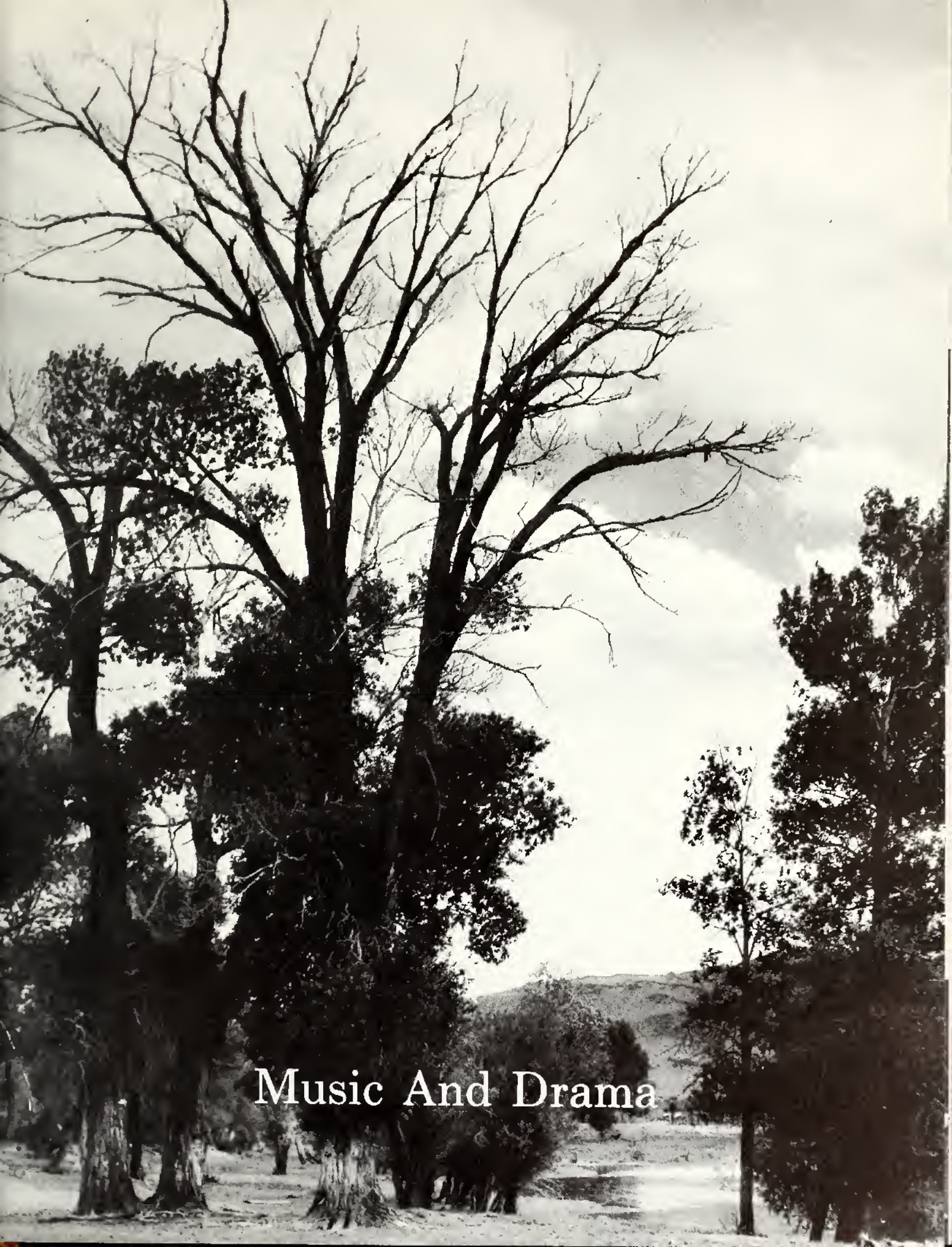
Under the directions of Coach Fisher, the women dominated the Frontier Conference meet, running up 124 points. (Western - the team in second place totaled only 63 points)

Some New Baby Spurs



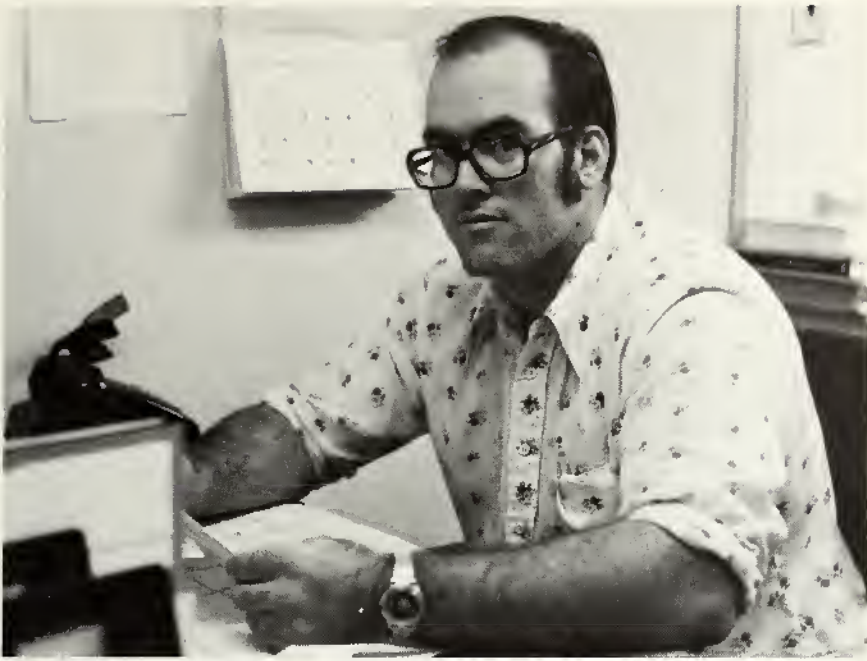
February 14th is Spur Founder's Day and this year's group celebrated by inviting all the old Spurs they could find to an afternoon party!

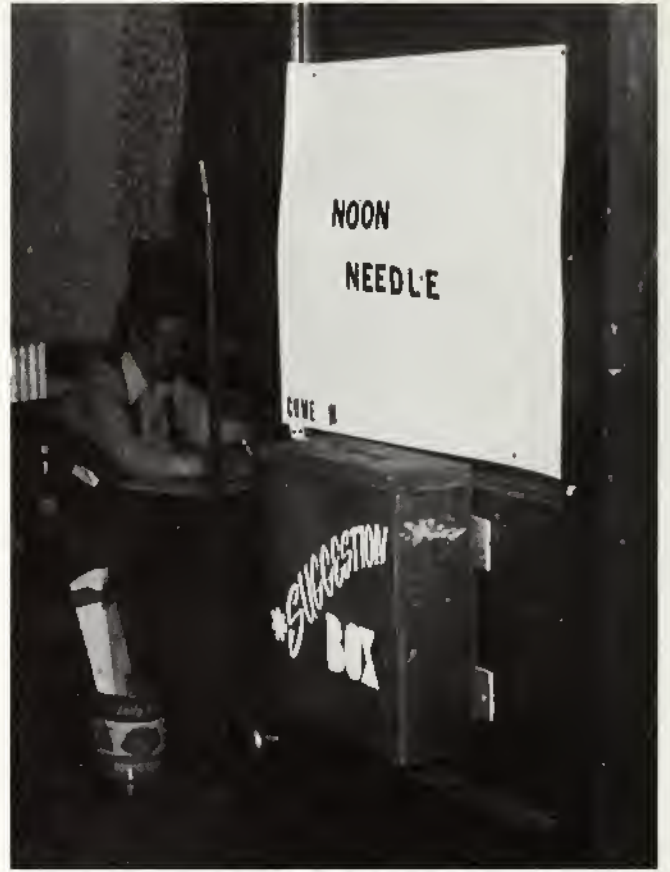

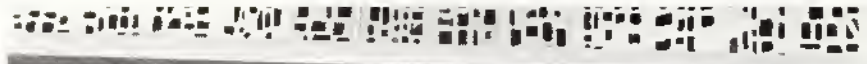
The first group to tour used Cathy Hansen, Laurie Michelson, Laura Stickney and Beth Sullivan.
