Al Guinn Returns To







You are cordially invited to join with us in this process of experimentation, and to share with us in the joy of discovery.















Some New Baby Spurs




February 14th is Spur Founder's Day and this year's group celebrated by inviting all the old Spurs they could find to an afternoon party!



The first group to tour used Cathy Hansen, Laurie Michelson, Laura Stickney and Beth Sullivan.


The second group contained the talents of Deb Glowaski, Jannie Harper, Bev McCurdy and Cindy Tintinger.
