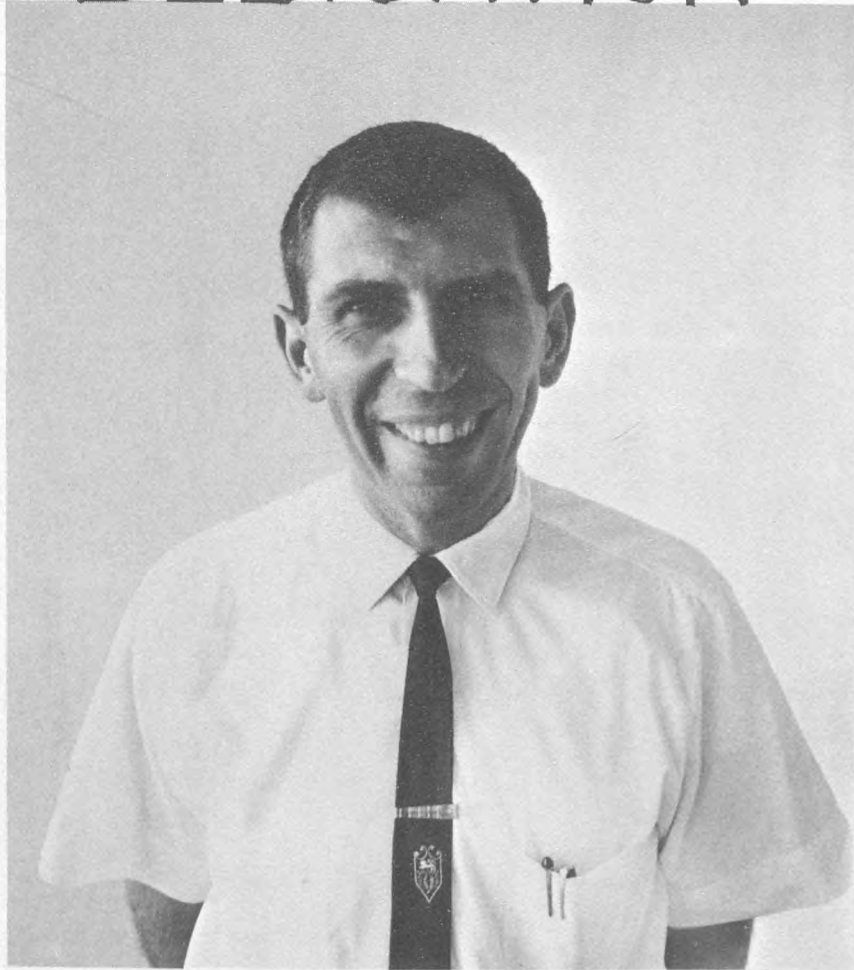

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



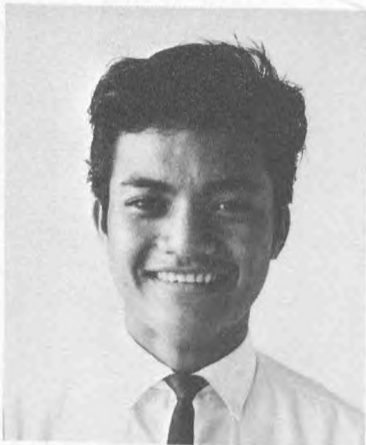
