Anderson, Elizabeth M., wife of the late Dr. Anderson of Virginia, U.S.A. Died 25th of January 1849. Buried St. Matthew's Cemetery.

Anderson, Georgia Hill, infant daughter of George Campbell Anderson. Died 2nd of June 1855. Buried St. Matthew's Church Cemetery.

Anderson, John, Esquire. Died 6th August 1838, age 76. Born 18th of June 1762, New York.

Anderson, Susanna H., relict of the late John Anderson, Esq.. Died 14th of December 1845, age 83 years. Born 11th April 1763, Savannah, Georgia. Buried St. Matthew's Cemetery.

Brown, Augustus Thayer, son of the Honorable Patrick Brown and his wife Harriot. Died 12th May 1822. Born 30th August 1816. Buried Western Cemetery.

Brown, Infant twin daughters, of Honorable Patrick Brown. Buried 25th Mary 1815. Buried Western Cemetery.

Brown, John, son of John and Susanna Brown. Died 17th January 1786. Born 12th December 1757. Old Cemetery on the Parade Ground.

Brown, Patrick Henry, son of Honorable Patrick Brown, Esquire and his wife, Harriot. Died 13th March 1815. Born 6th November 1812. Buried Western Cemetery.

Brown, Patrick, Honorable, died 15th June 1845, age 77 years. Buried Western Cemetery.

Brown, Sarah, daughter of Philip Brown, Esquire and his wife, Susannah, and sister of Honorable Patrick Brown. Died 5th October 1840, age 68 years. Buried Western Cemetery.

Hunt, Mary, wife of Thomas Hunt of Charleston, South Carolina. Died 7th August 1802, age 24 years. Buried Western Cemetery.

Inston, Eliza, wife of Robert Inston. Died 13th December 1863. Born 7th February 1832, Mobile, Alabama. Buried St. Matthew's Cemetery.

Inston, Robert, died 20th August 1865. Born 4th January 1828, Mobile, Alabama. Buried St. Matthew's Cemetery.

Johnson, Mary, wife of William Johnson and daughter of John and Mary Petty. Died 31 July 1802, age 34 years, 6 months and 25 days. Old Cemetery on the Parade Ground.

Pearce, Samuel, a shoemaker from North America. Died 19th June 1822. St. Matthew's Parish Records.

Petit, Margaret, died 2nd July 1863. Born 10th February 1812. Buried St. Matthew's Cemetery.

Stevens, Frederick, Purser in the Navy (Ship Boxer). Died 14th July 1843. Born 10th September 1818. Buried Western Cemetery.

Stockman, Elizabeth P., daughter of Jacob and Harriet Stockman. Died 9th August 1896. Born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Storr, Eliza, widow of the late Honorable John Storrs. Died 6th November 1855, age 66 years. Buried St. Matthew's Cemetery.

Storr, John, a native of St. Augustine, Florida. Died 2nd July 1846. Born 1783. Buried St. Matthew's Cemetery.

Thayer, James, son of William Thayer, Esquire of Providence, Rhode Island. Died 21st August 1817, age 21. Buried Western Cemetery.

Thompson, Lewis of South Carolina. Died 19th January 1816. St. Matthew's Parish Records.

Whippo, John of Connecticut. Died 30th June 1799, age 17. Old Cemetery on the Parade Ground.

Wilcocks, James of Philadelphia. Died 13th September 1814. St. Matthew's Parish Records.

Yoarison, James, an American soldier. Died 7th April 1849, age about 18. St. Matthew's Parish Records.
