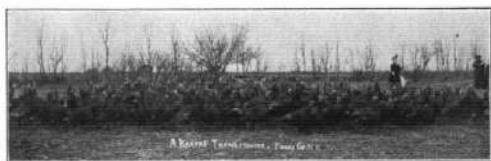




ALFALFA GROWN UNDER FARMER'S DITCH, Finney County, Kansas.

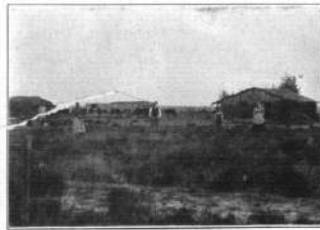

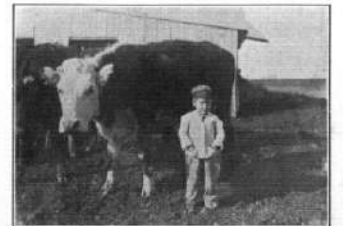

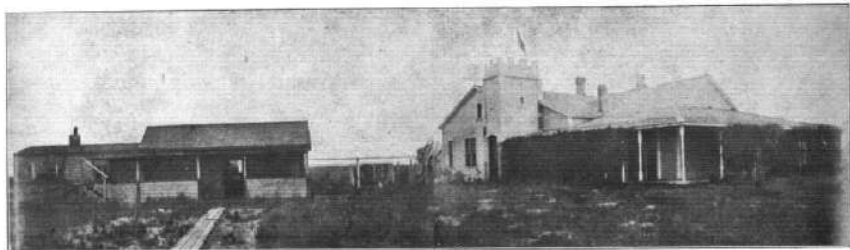
