The Deer, Elk, Wild Turkey are perfectly at home in Eastern Kansas and there are many thousands of acres in timber and brush that would be an ideal place for them. His geese and ducks are all as tame as any poultry on the farm. The deer are pets and the pheasants eat out of the hand. Wild turkeys are not subject to disease. Deer matures twice as fast as cattle and breeds twice as fast after they are mated. If the state would give any encouragement to such a project they would be plentiful in a few years.
