Plainville Concludes Best Sea

PLAINVILLE—Plainville's Cardinals, scoring an average of 32 points a game while holding opponents to 1.5 points, have completed the best season in school history.

Plainville captured the Mid-Continent League football title, piling up 288 points, while limiting the opposition to 14.

The Cards made 114 first downs to 52, gained 2131 yards rushing to 558, averaging 236.7 per contest to 62.

In the air, Plainville tried 73

passes, completed 27 for an average of 36.9. The opponents tried 90, hit 25 for a 27.7 average.

Plainville was penalized 395 yards, a 43.8 average. The opponents lost 255 yards, or 28.3 per game.

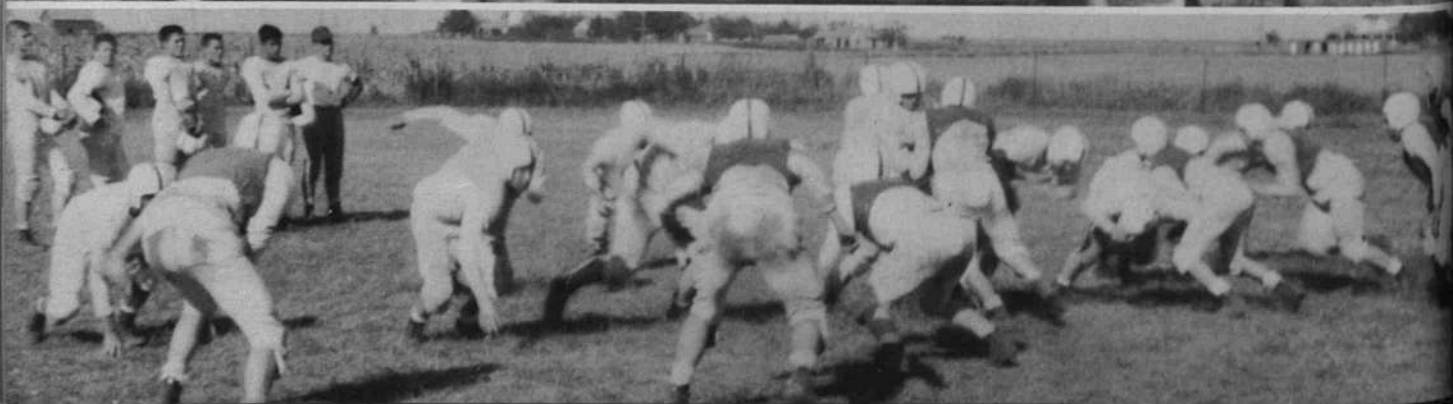
