Plainville Concludes Best Se

PLAINVILLE—Plainville's Cardinals, scoring an average of 32 points a game while holding opponents to 1.5 points, have completed the best season in school

Under the guidance of Coach Al Hargrave, the Cardinals rolled up nine victories, scoring eight of them by shutouts.

Plainville captured the Mid-Continent League football title, piling up 288 points, while limiting the opposition to 14.

The Cards made 114 first downs to 52, gained 2131 yards rushing to 558, averaging 236.7 per contest to 62

Strong In Air In the air, Plainville tried 73 passes, completed 27 for an average of 36.9. The opponents tried 90, hit 25 for a 27.7 average

Plainville intercepted 19 tosses and had four intercepted. The average interceptions was 2.1 pe. game, the opponents .44 per game.

Buster Hartnett, Cardinal quarterback, completed 18 passes for an average of 18.8 yards per completion. He carried 36 times for 205 yards, an average of 5.69 per carry.

Pat Shipman was on the receiving end of 10 passes for 185 yards and five touchdowns, an average of 18.5 yards per catch.

In passing, Plainville picked up 486 yards and 11 touchdowns, gaining 54 yards per game and 18.7

Plainville fumbled 17 times during the year, an average of 1.88 a game. The opponents fumbled 27 times, an average of three a game.

The Cardinals punted 21 times for 688 yards, a 32.8 average. The opponents punted 50 times for 1570 yards, averaging 31.4 yards per kick.

Plainville returned 34 punts for 593 yards, an average of 17.44 yards per return. The opponents returned 19 punts for 188 yards, an average of 9.73 per return.

Plainville was penalized 395 yards, a 43.8 average. The opponents lost 255 yards, or 28.3 per game.


