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Forward

I originally began this project with the sole intent of abstracting information on my Goodland families. Then I decided to make a brief index of all deaths with the hope of helping other researchers with their Goodland families. I hope that it serves that purpose.

The index at the front of this book is for death's that were mentioned, but not named. For example: "The father of Mary Jones" or "The brother of Mary Jones." In this case, the death would be in the index under Jones and a description of the relationship and then the page of the index that it can be found on.

All other deaths are listed alphabetically by the last name of the person who died.

This is just a brief index and is in no way intended to supply the complete information contained in the obituary. Although I tried to catch each and every death notice and obituary, I'm sure that I missed some. I highly recommend checking the newspaper if you can't locate a death that you feel should be included.

If you have the time, I also recommend spending some time with the Goodland paper. There's fascinating stories as well as information on every day occurrences that would be enjoyed by any researcher.
