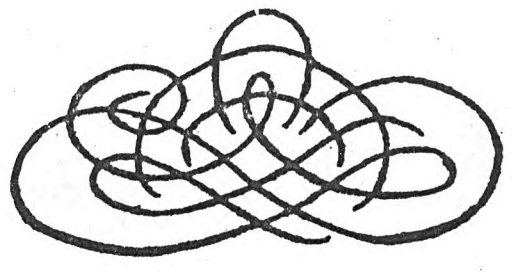

HOORAY!!! The Chicago Federal Records Center announced that the 1900 United States Census is being made public thru the Federal Record Centers. It is partly done now, Alabama thru Illinois, Roll 313, and that is available.

Earl G. Darby, 1412 LeGore Lane, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, retired KSU Professor, has done a number of Kansas census for some of the counties, 1880. Census for 1880 Riley County - \$6.00, 1880 Montgomery County \$10.00, Pottawatomie 1880 \$10.00, 1880 Marshall County \$8, 1880 Washington \$8, 1880 Clay County \$6.00, 1880 Wabaunsee \$5.00, 1880 Davis County (which is now Geary) \$3.50, 1880 Marion County \$6.00, 1880 Morris County \$5.00, he has also done for Riley County the 1855, 1857, 1860, 1865, 1870 and 1875 but no price was given. These are all available from Mr. Darby.

The following are the recorded deaths which were found in a huge book of Vital Statistics in the Wilson County Courthouse. These seem to be the only death records until 1911 when it became a law. Obviously, these are not the only deaths that occurred nor can we find out why only a few were done, but are simply thankful these were found. The entries were copied in their entirety, except for the omission of the undertaker.
