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INTRODUCTION

When we prepared our report on the cemeteries in the Town of Leeds, Maine, in 1967, we said that we hoped to return to Leeds to complete work on the two cemeteries which had been only partially done and to do the remaining four. In September, 1972 we returned to Leeds and transcribed all the inscriptions in the cemeteries that had not been finished in 1967 except for No. 20, the Caldwell Cemetery, shown on the map in our 1967 report. The Caldwell Cemetery was reported by Mrs. Turner, Town Clerk of Leeds, to be no longer in existence, the gravestones having disappeared and the field plowed for crops some years ago.

The results of our 1972 trip should have been reported long ago, but a series of illnesses occurred and the records were tucked away and forgotten until a request came for permission to microfilm our 1967 report. So, belatedly, the information obtained in 1967 is now presented. The listings follow the form of the 1967 report—see page 2 of that report. A separate index for this report is included. In the case of the Additon and Francis Cemeteries, a complete relisting has been done for the convenience of the user.

Copies of this 1972 report are being forwarded to the Maine Old Cemeteries Association and to the Maine State Library.

16. ADDITON CEMETERY - REVISED

This very old cemetery is on the north side of Anson Road, approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mi. east of its intersection with Additon Road. The area is heavily wooded and moisture has taken a great toll of the gravestones. The Anson Road is very sandy, and care should be taken in traversing it.

In 1967, we reported a partial recording of inscriptions in the cemetery. We revisited the cemetery in 1972 and recorded all legible inscriptions on the gravestones.

17. QUAKER RIDGE CEMETERY

This cemetery lies on the north side of Amson Rd., approximately 2 mi. east of the intersection of Anson and Additon Rds. Caution is advised in driving to this cemetery since the hill down to is is very sandy and slippery. Since the bridge at the east end of the road is out and the hill so likely to be difficult it would be wise to leave word with someone before going to this cemetery.

In a wooded area, the stones in this cemetery were more badly weathered than in any other Leeds cemetery, probably less than half now theing readable. Although the cemetery was associated with the Quakers, as shown by the form of date used on a few gravestones, it is believed many non-quakers were buried here.

18. EVERETT CARVER CEMETERY

This small cemetery lies on a knoll northwest of the end of Campbell Rd., nearly 2 mi. north of the intersection of Campbell Rd. with State Highway 219. The cemetery is not visible from the road and guidance of the Town Sexton is advised if anyone wants to visit it. Only one gravestone survives in the cemetery. Though named for the owner of the farm on which it was established, members of the Everett Carver family were buried in the Dead River (Knapp) Cemetery.

19. STINCHFIELD or OLD INDIAN CEMETERY

This cemetery lies on a knoll behind the bridge across the Dead River on State Highway 106 and about 2 mi. north of the village of Leeds. According to Edwin Longley, Jr., owner of the Riverbend Campground at the foot of the knoll, only two burials were made in the cemetery--that of Paul Marshfield and of an Indian boyhood friend of his, a rough rock, without inscription, marking the Indian's grave.
