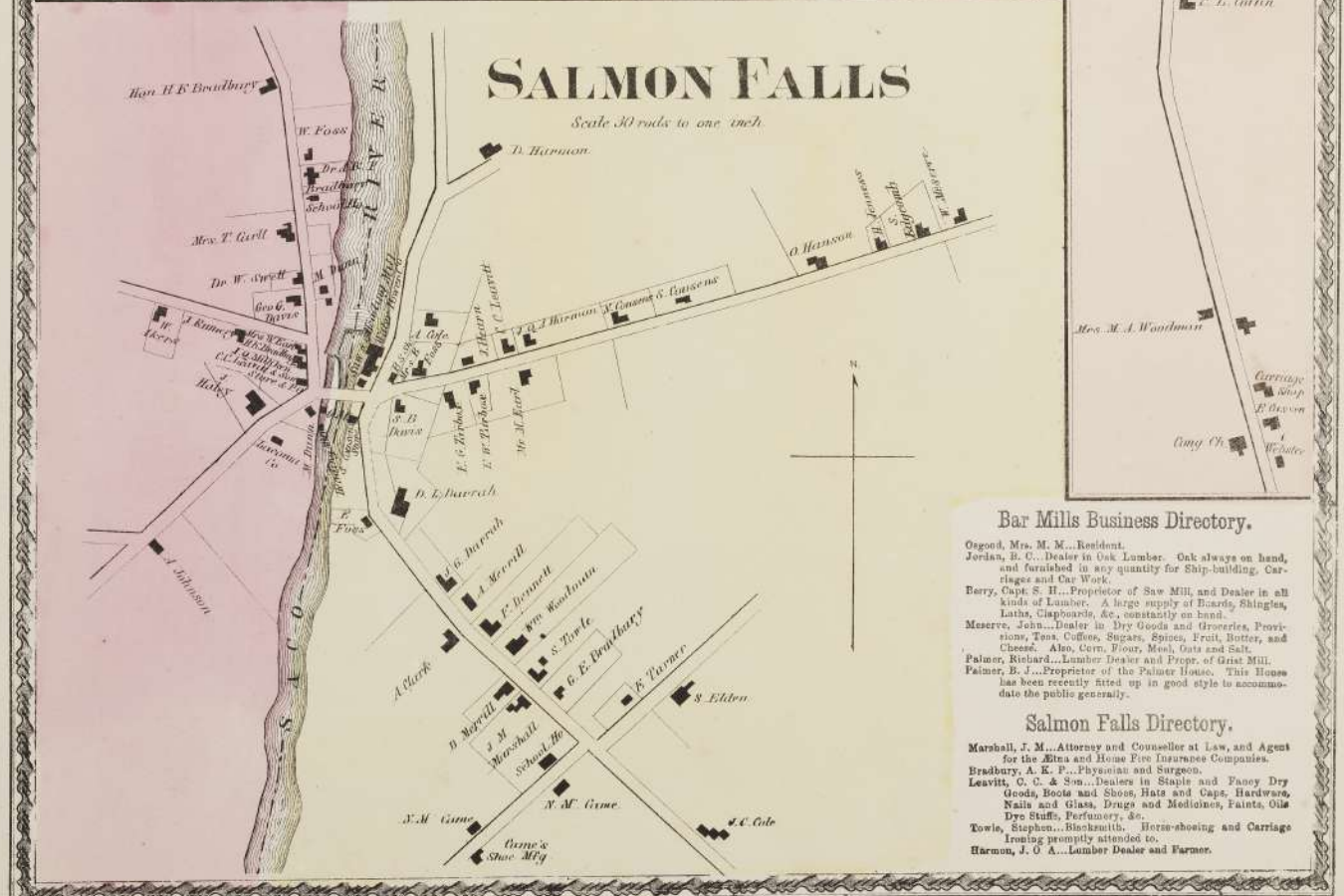

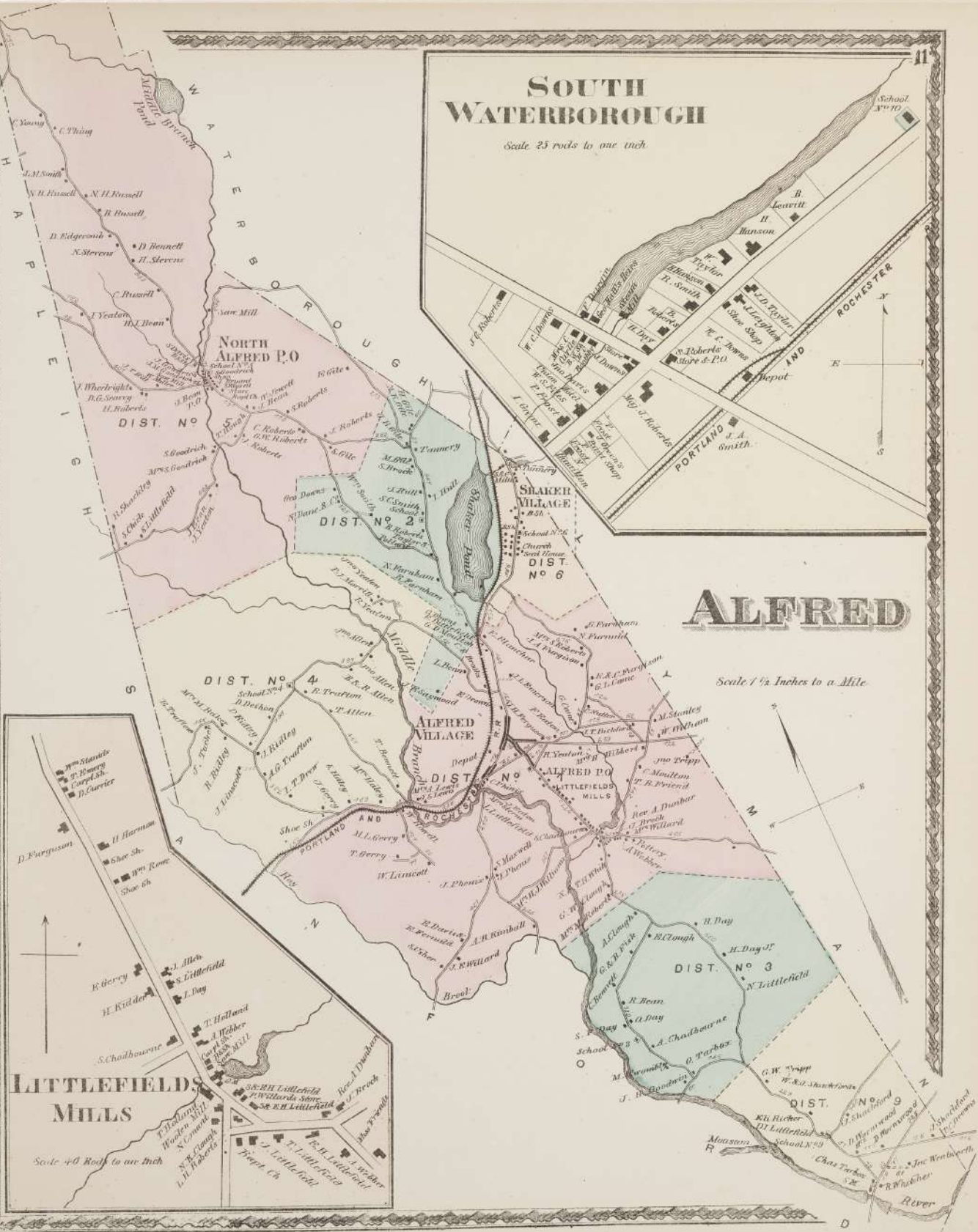

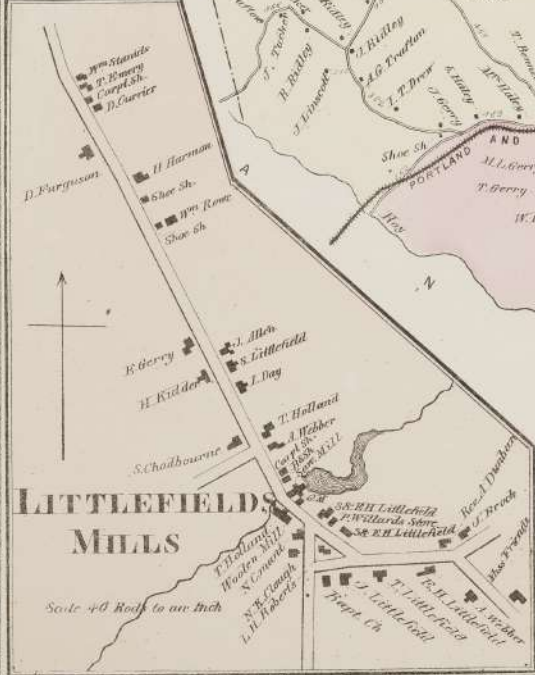

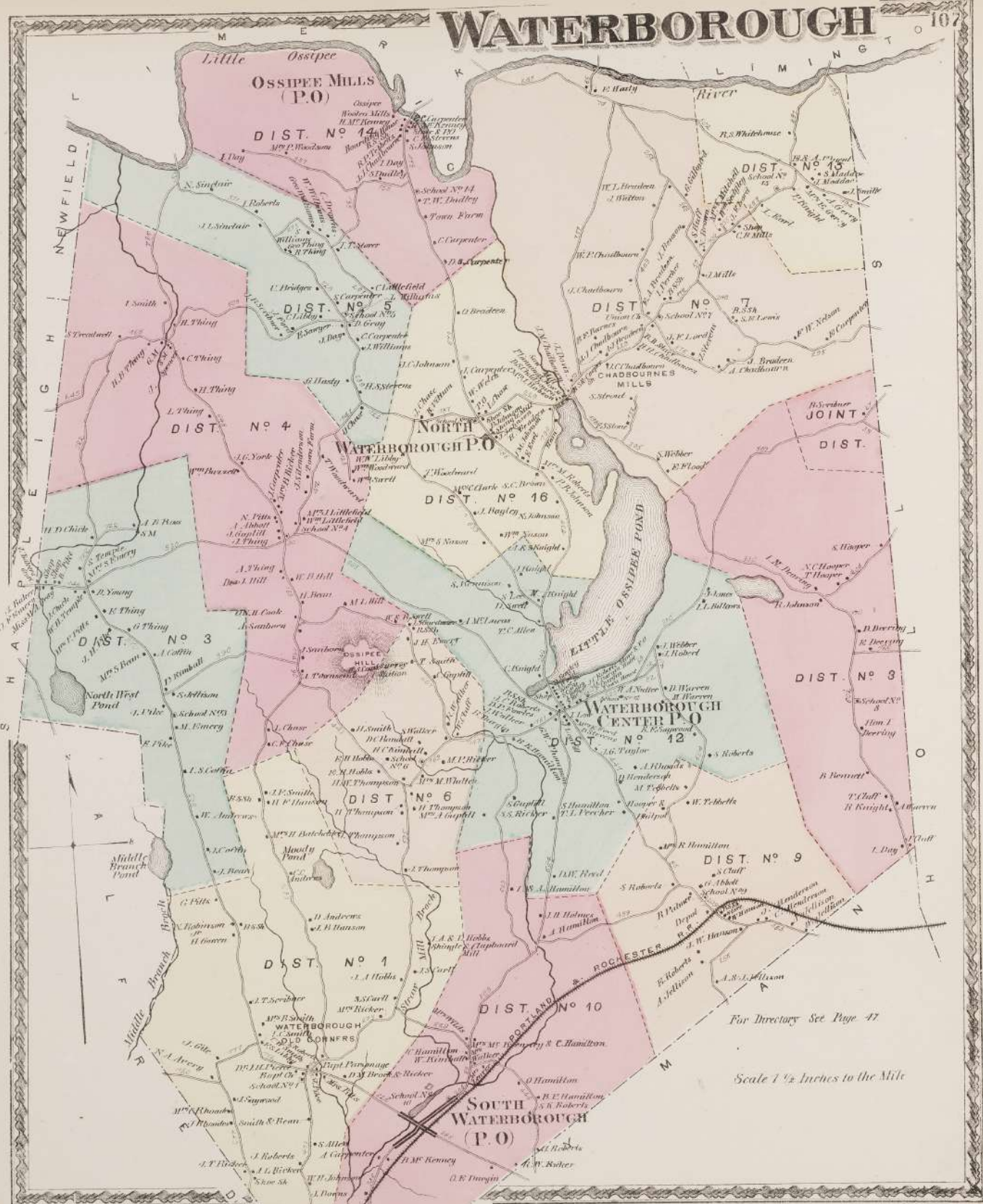
SPRING VALE

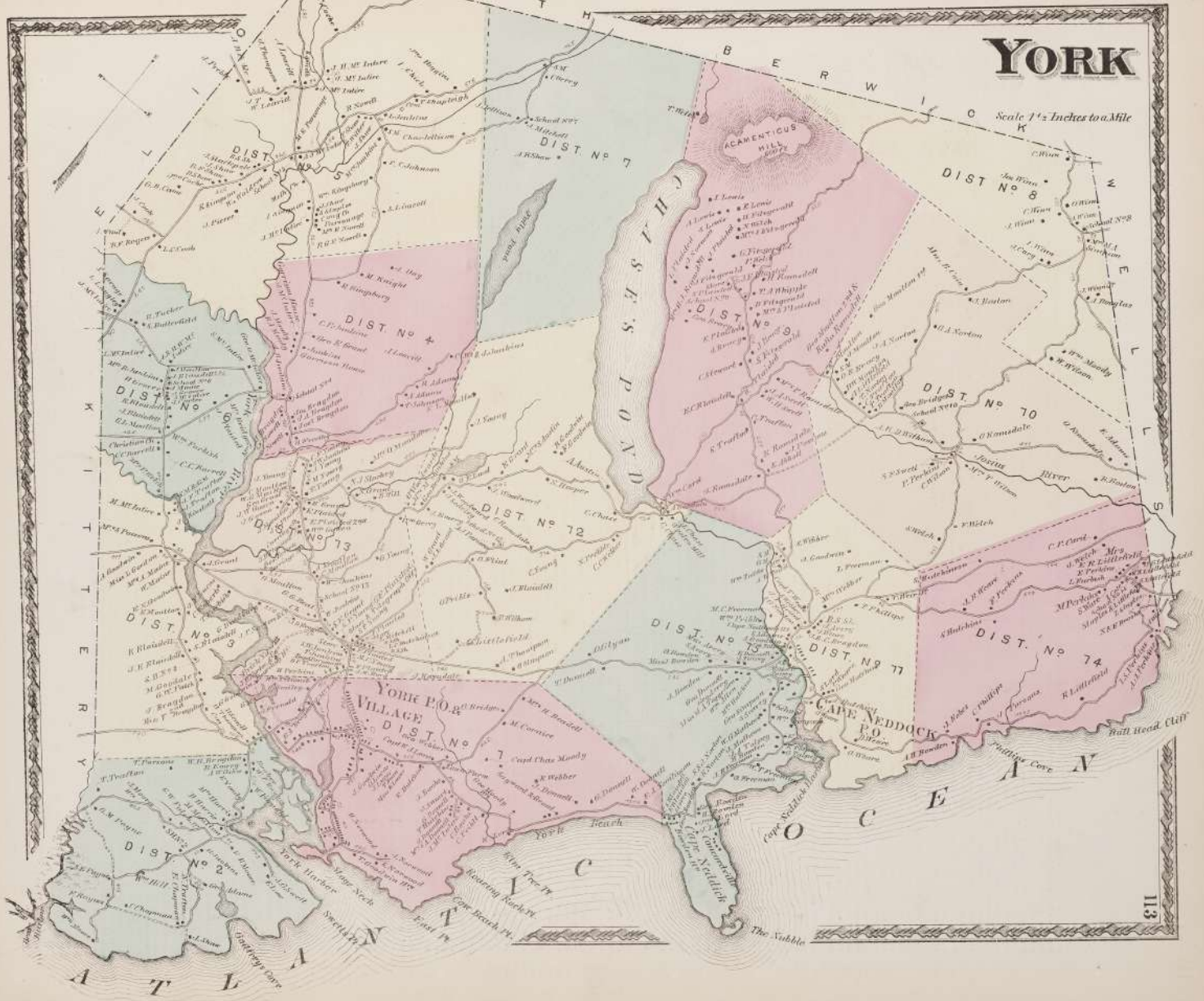

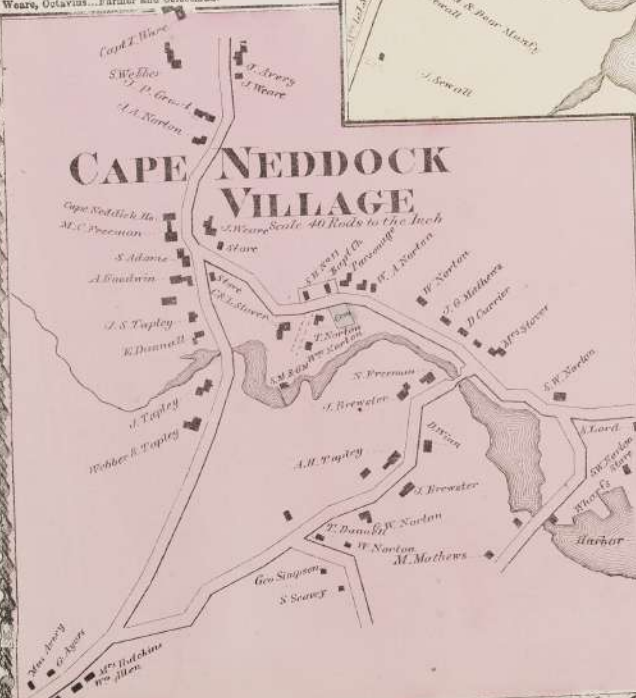
