party, still the Democrats succeeded in electing fair and liberal-minded men to all the offices in the county. Increase Adams, J. B. Morris and B. H. Wilder were placed on the County Court bench, B. P. Ritchie, was the Representative to the Legislature, and J. W. Carson was elected Sheriff.

Under the administration of this court the county subscribed \$300,000 to the L. and M. R. R., and also had the present Court-House erected at a cost of \$45,000. This new road comes into this county at the northeast corner, intersects the N. M. R. at Mexico, and thence S. to the Callaway line—a length of thirty-nine miles inside the county, making with the N. M. over sixty miles of railroad in her border.

Notwithstanding the enormous debt of over \$300,000, and the questionableness of the legality of the subscription, she has never for an instant entertained a thought or wish to avoid it, and stands to-day in the commercial world without a stain upon her name.

In 1868, J. D. MacFarlane, Liberal, was sent to the Legislature over W. T. Cook, ultra. Cook contested, and MacFarlane resigned, whereupon M. F. Simmons was elected by the same party over R. M. Sturgeon, ultra—and J. W. Carson was re-elected Sheriff. 1870, five years after the war had ended, was the first time for ten years that the whole people had a voice in public affairs, and this was due in part to the lib-

erality in sentiment of the emigration from the loyal States that came in after the close of the war.

At this election, Henry Williams, Democrat, was elected to the Legislature, over James Carroll, Circuit Clerk; John Gregg, Recorder of Deeds; Wm. H. White, Sheriff; B. L. Locke, County Court Clerk; Jno. G. Coil, Treasurer.

1872.—Mortimer McIlhany, Democrat, elected to the Legislature, John J. Stule, Sheriff; B. R. Cauthorn, Collector of the Revenue; Daniel H. McIntyre, Prosecuting Attorney.

In 1872 the only changes were to elect Z. J. Ridgeway a member of the Legislature and John M. Gordon, Prosecuting Attorney.

The population of this County in 1870 was not less than 14,000, and of this the city of Mexico had about 5,000.

Her educational advantages are equal to any in the State; besides public schools in every district there is at Mexico, Hardin College, an institution handsomely endowed by the munificence of a single individual, Gov. Charles H. Hardin. It is a large, commodious brick structure. It is under the management of Prof. A. W. Terrill, as President, and has a full corps of competent teachers. There is also a male school established by Prof. H. M. Hamill, and under his management has won a favorable reputation at home and abroad.

The Public School building in Mexico, reared at a cost of over \$20,000, will accommodate 600 scholars. Mexico has ten churches, most of them large, elegant brick edifices.

It has no less than forty large business houses, engaged in retailing dry goods and groceries. Four banks, with an aggregate capital of nearly half a million dollars.

The shipment of stock from this place for a single year was 414 car-loads, and of corn and oats 1032 car-loads, besides a large amount of hides, game, &c.

Vandalia and Laddonia on the Louisiana and Mississippi River Railroad, and Martinsburg, on the North Missouri Railroad, are the only other villages within the County.

It has been less than forty years since the organization of the County, and now it has a population of 20,000, with a taxable wealth of \$6,000,000, and her public debt does not exceed \$125,000.

With her hundred schools and churches, her sixty-two miles of railroad, her 600 square miles of prolific and generous lands, her public spirit and her brave yeomanry, she may fearlessly look forward to the future and proudly read in her own name and a fame as glorious as that of any in the land.
