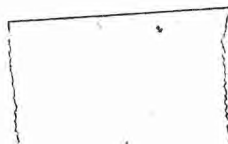

CASS COUNTY, MISSOURI**

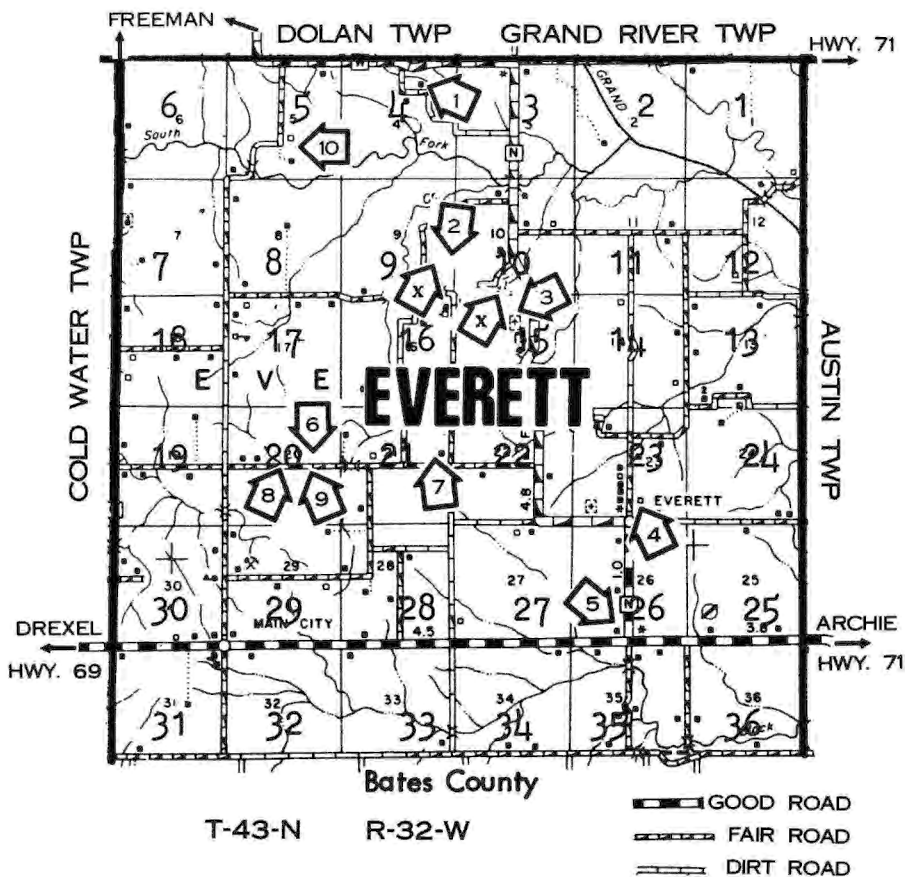
Compiled for the Cass County, Missouri Historical Society, Inc., from tombstone inscriptions, family records and personal interviews. Donald Lewis Osborn, 322 Willow Way, Lee's Summit, Mo., completed the tombstone inscriptions from the 4 cemeteries of the township during the summer of 1972. The Shiply family with information given by Eliza Brewer Shipley, Annie Shipley Hocker, and Martha Plattner Shipley made an index of the Moudy Cemetery in 1965. Information from this index which is different from or not included in the Osborn tombstone transcriptions is noted in this Index of the Moudy Cemetery by an*. Location of other burial sites have been given by interested residents of the township. Note that the 3 older cemeteries are known by more than one name. 1. Man and wife and colored boy. South of Glenn Ford house. Sec. 4.
2. Cemetery called Clary, Rock Quarry, Sandridge or Amarugia Hill; Sec. 9.
3. Cemetery called Moudy or Herrell (also Amarugia) Sec. 15.
4. Cemetery called Everett Sec. 23.
5. 10-12 graves in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26 now a field.
6. 4 or 5 graves S $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 20. Stones removed and graves plowed over.
7. 1 grave NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21 in barnlot of this farm.
8. Negro boy buried in Sec. 20 or 29 by Whit Cecil as he was excluded from Everett Cemetery. (See page 7 of Tales of Amarugia Highlands by Donald Lewis Osborn)
9. Little girl who died with cholera. Was buried with a gold ring on her finger at "Cooks Bluff" S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 20 or N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 29.
10. Cemetery called Williamson or Davidson Sec. 5.
11. X in Sec. 9 is house to ask permission to visit. Cemetery in Sec. 9.
12. X in Sec. 15 is house to ask permission to visit Moudy Cemetery.

MEMORIAL DAY AT EVERETT MAY 29, 1896

(Copied from the Austin in **GAR Post Record** Book by Marjorie Patterson)

Memorial Day 1896 began as usual on the 29 when the comrades detailed, and some who volunteered, met at the Everett School House where perhaps 50 people not including the scholars had gathered.

Promptly at 11 A.M. every seat being occupied, the house was called to order, by Commander Whitman, who made a few remarks, and turned the stage over to Mr. C.G. Conn, teacher of the school, under whose direction the following program was very finely rendered.

Moved by Brice McCoy, se. by Comrad Hoots that a vote of thanks be extended to Prof. Conn and scholars, for their very appropriate entertainment. Carried unanimous. Commander Whitman now introduced Col. A.J. Briggs, who delivered a part only of his very fine address, he having been sick in bed the two preceding days.

Line of march was now taken to the Cemetery, composed of 10 veterans, 30 or more children and 12 conveyances of various kinds, also by many who were not present at the school house. At the cemetery, square was formed around the grave of JVC John W. Page, and the GAR service for the occasion was read by the commander and the officer of the day, after which the children strewed flowers on the graves of C.C. Cotz, Thos. Hoots, J.W. Page, Daniel Page, William Phillips, Eli Murz and Mr. Meyers, also Joe DeJarnett, and exconfederate. The school sang an appropriate song and ranks were broken, to meet here again in 1897.
