Membership in the FFA is made up of farm boys who are students of Vocational Agriculture in high school. The organizations

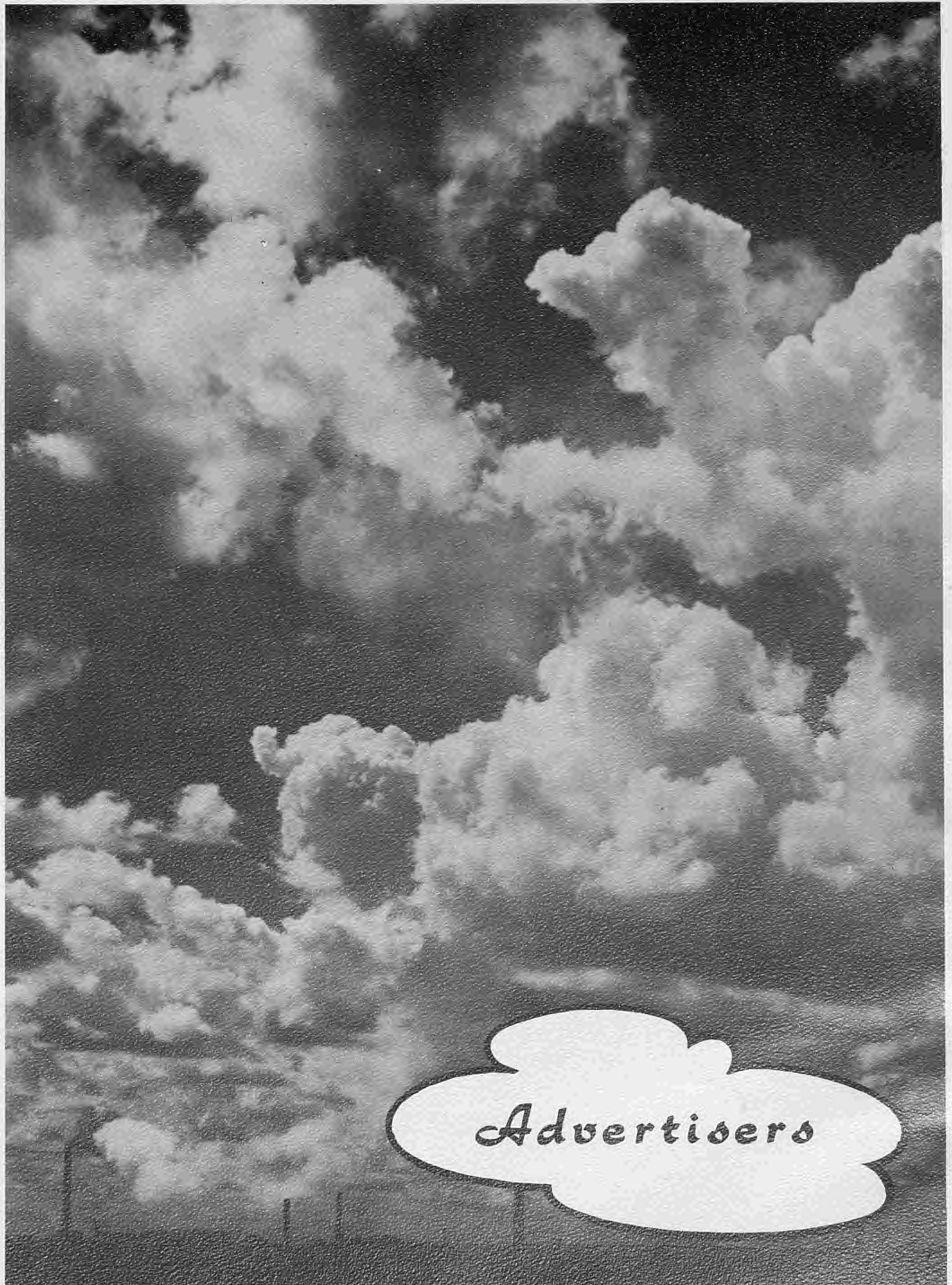
activities are designed primarily to help develop aggressive agricultural leadership, citizenship, and cooperation and to stimulate the boys to work harder in all areas of life.

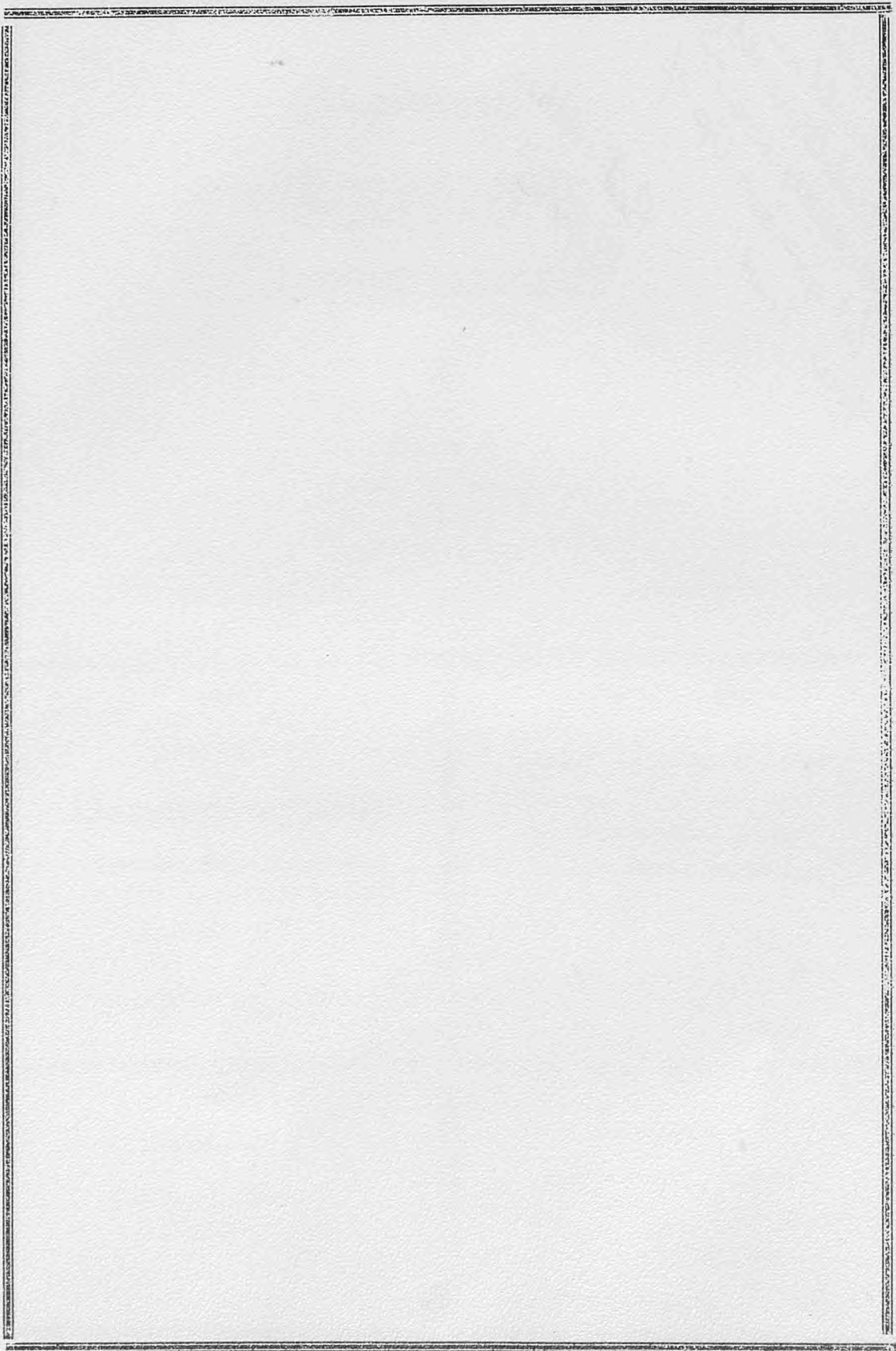
