Woods Cemetery

Located NE $\frac{3}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 60, township 57, range 31, on farm of the late Mrs. William Irminger, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles southeast of Liberty.

William Wood, born Nov. 29, 1770, died 1835, stone gone, in Albemarle county, Virginia, son of Isaac Wood and Susanna Grayson, moved to Clay county, Mo., in 1832. This same year he purchased a large tract of school land southeast of Liberty.

The Wood family were not destined to enjoy their Missouri home for long. William Wood died in the early fall of 1835 of malaria; his wife, Sarah, following him in a few weeks, stricken with the same dread malady.

Through the courtesy of the late Mrs. William Irminger, who subsequently became owner of the Wood farm, I obtained information of the Wood burial ground. The cemetery is about one hundred feet to the right of the house as it faces the main highway. But, there is nothing now to indicate this sacred spot of pioneer dust. The little fence that once surrounded it has been removed, also all the white Italian marble headstones, that once marked the different graves that laid out under the protecting arms of a tree. The ground has been plowed over, and when I saw it some years ago all that remained was the stump of this tree.

A sad picture, but the march of time and progress seems to level all things, and those who laid the foundation of our great country, have passed into the forgotten realm.

In my search over the place I found quite a few of the headstones, though some were broken and not easy to decipher. Here is the list of those I found, though there were others, I was told, but could not find them.

History of Woodland Church and Graveyard

Woodland church was organized about 1870-72. The frame building was erected at a cost of about \$2000. Some of the first members were Jas. E. Bohart, Richard P. Funk, Solomon Welton, J. W. Bradley and A. J. Roberts. Among the earlier ministers who served the church were Elders Josiah Waller, Baird Waller, William Stephens, John Perkins, T. Trader and Revs. Williamson and Akers. About 20 years ago after the church became quite delapidated a windstorm razed the building. Nearby is the church graveyard, plainly seen from highway No. 10, about ten miles east of Liberty.

Lufflough Graveyard

Located: S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 52, Range 31

Lufflough said to have been a lawyer. Grave on James McCue farm, and enclosed within a rock wall. Large flat tombstone has fallen face down, so inscription is impossible to get. Some information says his name was Laidlow. He hanged himself on farm where buried.

Field Graveyard

This graveyard is one of the very few found on farms that has been preserved. Enclosed in a concrete wall near the old home. Here Judge Joseph Thornburg Field settled when he came to Clay county. Born in Madison county, Virginia, the eldest of nine children, later settled in Boone county, Ky., from whence he emigrated to Clay county. In 1845 he was married to Miss Mary A. Thompson of Caldwell county, Mo.; she survived her marriage on a short time leaving him a daughter, Mary Margaret Wymore became his second wife. A third time he married Amanda Jane Brassfield. Of this union four children were born.

Mt. Zion Baptist Church and Graveyard

Located N. E. corner of S. E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 30, Twp. 50, Range 30. East off highway No. 10, several miles east of Liberty, Mo.

This church was organized in April, 1853, its constituent members being John G. Price, Jas. Munkirs, Wm. B. Hodges, Jas. T. Withers, Wm. H. Price, Thos. Holders, Daniel H. Sans, Thos. Y. Gill, Geo. H. McNealy, Louisiana Hogen, Sarah E. Withers, Amanda Mosby, Agnes Munkirs, Susan G. Withers, Margaret Guar, America Price, Julia Gill and Martha Withers.

Pastors who served in the early history of the church were: Elders Wm. H. Price, Henry Hill, Wm. T. Brown and Jas. Duvall. The church built of brick at a cost of \$1500. was the first brick church to be built in Clay County, out side of Liberty.

Some eight years ago the church was razed, the brick sold to Dr. Crawford of Excelsior Springs, who built a nice home, using the old brick in the construction of a home.

This week's graveyard records from the D. A.R. historian are the first in a series from the Muddy Fork cemetery. This cemetery will be 97 years old October 2, 1947, according to an article by the Rev. C. V. Froman, of Excelsior Springs, which was published in the 1946 Clay-Ray Life edition of the Daily Standard.

The following is an excerpt from the Rev. Froman's recollections about the cemetery:

"This historic old pioneer cemetery has back of its origin the story of two remarkable men: Ryland Shackelford of Kentucky, who came to Clay County in 1830, and Joseph Scudder, of New Jersey, who came to this county about 1836.

Both were outstanding leaders, men of education, ability, force, character, wealth, and position. They were staunch Old School Presbyterians for over 40 years charter members of Bethel Presbyterian church at its organization in 1842, and were closely associated in church life for more than 30 years. The two men were also connected by ties of marriage. Ryland Shackelford himself and Silence Jane Scudder, a daughter of Joseph Scudder, both marrying into the same family.

As early as 1845 there was evidently a group of Old School Presbyterians in the country some four miles north of Kearney, who apparently were holding their religious services in the Muddy Fork school house. They were trying to organize their group into a congregation in 1849, but something delayed their work.

Some time between April and June, 1850, they were organized into the Clear Fork Presbyterian church, named after the west branch of Clear creek, and Ryland Shackelford and Joseph Scudder were elected elders of this church, positions they held for many years. On October 2, 1850, Shackelford and Scudder brought one acre of ground from James Shackelford, a brother of Ryland Shackelford. A church building was built on the site and a cemetery started. This acre lies in the center of Muddy Ford cemetery. In 1855 Shackelford and Scudder brought another strip of adjoining land for cemetery purposes, and in 1870 the same two men bought another piece of ground and added it to the burial ground."

Barry Graveyard

The Barry graveyard is located in Gallatin township NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, section 10, twp. 51, range 33. Gallatin township in 1822 comprised the western half of Clay county, Mo. Barry was established first as an Indian trading post about the year of 1830, before the Platte purchase.

Barry is ten miles west of Liberty and about the same distance north of Kansas City, Mo. The Women's Extension club of Barry community recorded the Barry graveyard records as one of their projects for 1947, and sent in 416 names-many persons being early day pioneers of Clay county. The genealogical chairman of Alexander Doniphan Chapter of the D. A. R. expresses appreciation for the work of those who compiled these records.

John Majors, a Revolutionary soldier, born April 22, 1759 and died December 22, 1844. He came to Clay county, Mo., from Wayne county, Kentucky, in 1838. After coming to Clay county he lived only six years. Soon after arriving he pointed to a spot on a hill near the old home, $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles northwest of Excelsior Springs, Mo., and said, "This is where I want to be buried. His wishes were carried out and so began the Majors' burying ground.

Record of war service: Date of enlistment and length of service:

July or August, 1776, 5 months, 14 days. Officers: Richard Goode, Joseph Williams, N. Car., Oct. 10, 1779, 5 months; 1780-1781 service about 1 year, Minute Men, James Sheppard, Bostick, Smith, Looin, Major Winston, Locke, N. Car.; 1781 served 3 months, Minor Smith, Light Horse Service.

Battles engaged in: Waccaman and Guilford, Residence of Soldier at Enlistment, Surry Co., N. Car., Date of application for pension, Sept. 24, 1832. Residence at date of application, Wayne Co., Ky., age at date of application, born April, 1759, in Baltimore, Md.

Remarks: Lived in Clay county, Mo., in 1838. For date of last payment of pension, \$80. per 12 months, and probable date of death, September 4, 1844.

About 1908 the Elizabeth Benton chapter of DAR, Kansas City Mo., placed a Revolutionary marker on the grave of John Majors. From the department of Interior, Washington, D. C., Feb. 6, 1908.
