Early Day Marriages

Letters recently presented to the Cole County Historical Society reveal interesting details of a wedding in Jefferson City Dec. 26, 1855.

The letters, presented to the society by Mrs. Howard Boone, the former Janet Ewing, of Kansas City, were written by her grandfather, Robert Ewing, and her uncle, H. Clay Ewing, long a prominent jurist of Jefferson City. They were sent to Col. A. Long of St. Louis and Washington, D.C., a relative of the Ewing family.

Descriptions in the letters of the mode of travel in the 1850's, and the general condition of life of the period give a vivid picture of the discomforts prevalent during those days.

Robert Ewing, who wrote one of the letters, was also the grandfather of Mrs. Ann Ewing Hobbs of New York and the late Mrs. Olive Ewing Dallmeyer, for whom the local music club is named.

Early Settlers in County

The Ewing family was among the first settlers of Cole county and Mrs. Robert Ewing drew the first map of Jefferson City, at the time the town was established on ground designated by the federal government.

Their home, Buena Vista plantation, was long a historic landmark on the south bank of the Missouri river, eight miles east of Jefferson City. The property is today owned by the state and is the location of Algoa Farms.

H. Clay Ewing's home stood on a high terrace, now the location of the Capitol theatre. He was attorney general of Missouri from 1872 to 1874.

The following letter was written by Robert Ewing at Buena Vista December 31, 1855:

"We received yours of the 8th inst. and were sorry to hear Maria was not as well as she had been, but we very much hope that she has, before now, recovered her health. But you did not say a word in your letter about the 14-pound baby.

Reckless Legislature Generous

"Clay came to Jefferson City with his wife last Friday, two weeks, but has not been down here yet. The weather has been very bad and she has the chills and they thought it not prudent to turn out in this weather.

"I suppose now my order will be paid at maturity, since the reckless legislature has given the railroad every thing they asked. I would have given them, I believe, double as much if they had asked it. If it is not paid, I want you to take that course with it that will secure payment with all damages. If I cannot collect there I think I can make Grain good for it here as he has taken another contract but would rather you collect it there.

"Sometime at your leisure call in a wagon maker and ask what a good medium two horse wagon can be gotten for, and the difference in price between a wooden and iron axeled wagon, if any, and let me know in your next letter.

"The Moreau river tressle work has been twice washed away and it is no nearer done now than last fall, except that the timbers are all on the ground and nearly all framed. I don't undertake to guess when it will be finished.

Wedding in 'High Life'

"Tell Maria we have had a wedding in High Life here. William Glernin Jefferson and Miss Christina Ewing were married by Rev. Uncle Jacob Bolton on the 26th of December at Judge Ewing's.

"The table literally groaned under the wine flasks, the cake, the turkeys, the pigs, etc. The dresses of the bride and bridesmaids were beautifully thin and light for the season and state of the weather. The thermometer being down to 14 degrees below zero that morning.

"Well, here we have been shut up for a week and a half and cold at that, by this severe storm of snow and cold weather. The longest and most severe cold we have had for many winters with no company, nothing to read, and not knowing how the 'world wagoth without.' The only possible amusement for me was to sit and pick cotton day and night and night and day.

"You may guess that I had the blues most awfully and I have seen people clearer of them than I am yet—Oh what an awfully lonesome time of it we have had.

Cites Other Marriages

"Martha Parberry is married to a Frenchman. Virginia Parsons is married to G. C. Berry and Miss Cardill from Virginia to a U.S. Engineer Harding. Miss Margaret Palmer is married to

Little Tom Bolton and it is said that Miss Betty — will soon be married to an Engineer Mase, a Dutchman. And it is thought that Mrs. H. wants to be married to somebody. You see I have given you all the news and some of the town gossip.

"We are all well, thank God, notwithstanding the weather, and it is moderating a little. I forgot to say that I have seen Clay's wife and think I shall like her very much. She seems to be very kind and familiar without any airs. Write to us often and write long letters. All the particulars, especially about yourself and family.

Very truly your friend and obedient servant,

R. E. Ewing."

Two other letters were presented to the society by Mrs. Boone, both written by H. Clay Ewing to Col. Long. They are as follows:

"Dear Colonel:

Anticipates Lively Winter

"Yours of the 29th is at hand, for which together with the sundries sent from St. Louis. Please receive my acknowledgement. I received your letter per Judge Morrison with enclosure correct, found out you would leave perhaps before my letter reached you and sent by Jim Lusk who was going down for the things I wrote to you.

"We anticipate quite a lively time here this winter, several young lady visitors expected, three here now. General —'s two daughters and a Miss Richie.

"Tell Maria that I think I'll be able to marry this winter, that is, if I can do so before they find me out. I have gone through the whole catalogue here and here about, but have not been able to get one. But jesting aside, I look forward to the coming season with fear and trembling or in other words, I would greatly prefer one of our quiet winters without visitors or legislature, for I detest jams above all things.

"When the legislature meets I shall try and inform you of the items of the season, such things as don't go into the public prints.

"All well and nothing new about town, except that our Thespians are progressing beautifully—we will have a first rate orchestra of which I am a humble member. I'll write to Maria ere long. Tell Maria if she finds a real first rate waltz or two, polka or schottisch, she must send me the music.

The second letter was written December 20, 1854, from Philadelphia.

"Dear Colonel:

Rail Travel 'Infamous'

"I take it that it is confounded hard that I can come this near and not be able to go to Washington, but such is the fact. I was called to this place suddenly on business leaving home on the 21st, not knowing in the morning that day that I had to come, and reached here on the 28th. I expected when I left home to be able to spend at least three or four days with you, but I have been delayed so that I will be unable even to go to Washington at all. I must be at home ex-necessitate, by the eighth of January. Should I go to Washington City could only remain til Tuesday morning at the extent and then, if delayed at all, not get there in time, thereby being able to be in Washington only from Sunday til Tuesday, whereas by going directly from here I'll have time

to go by the way of Wheeling and the Ohio river, which is now up, and thereby have a greatly preferable trip to going all the way by railroad (a most infamous way of traveling.)

An Unpleasant Trip

"I had a very unpleasant trip out. In the first place the steamer Winchester was befogged, making me lose the morning train and when, within ten miles of Alton, unshipped her rudder and at the same time the fog increased in density. Then about 2 o'clock in the evening, when several of us hired a wagon to take us up, paying two dollars apiece, before we reached Alton however (having a most delightful trip through the mud,) the weather cleared up, the rudder was shipped, and the boat beat us to Alton. We left that night, reached Chicago next day a little too late for the Eastern train, per arrangement as I verily believe, and therefore we had to pay tribute to that infamous Abolition Hole, where we lost six hours. Within fifty miles of Cleveland we were detained sometime. All things therefore taken together, I am unable to visit you as I very much desired, but I have two estates to sell out as Admr., commencing on the eighth of January. I left an agent to attend thereto, yet it is all important that I should be present.

"Tell Maria that I wrote her a long letter, before leaving home, giving her all current news about town, that I would have been very glad to see what airs she puts on in the city of Washington, but am unable to do so. I leave this evening for home.

A record of 300 marriage licenses issued to early Cole county residents has just been compiled by the Cole County Historical Society and the Daughters of the American Revolution.

The marriage records from 1821 to 1851 had never before been copied and the work, done by Mrs. Henry Ellis, was made very difficult by the fact that the book had gone through several fires and is badly faded and torn.

The marriages of many noted couples and the names of families prominent in the history of Cole county and Missouri are found in the lists.

Publication of this list will begin today and be continued at intervals, with biographical sketches of various couples written by members of the D.A.R. and the historical society.

Names of present-day citizens of Cole county listed among the licenses are Steininger, Sone, Vivion, Enloe, Ramsey, Goode, Coffelt, Bolton, Heisinger, Bedford, Henley, LePage, Lauf, Bradbury, Winston, Dulle, Dampf, Bruns, Loesch, Roark, Wallendorf, Eveler, Amos, Henley, Schubert, and Hemmel.

Between the years 1830 and 1841, a large number of the marriages were performed by George Tompkins, judge of the Missouri supreme court.

Vivion Marriages Listed

Seven marriage licenses were issued between 1823 and 1842 to persons of the Vivion family.

Two of these were daughters of John Vivion who, with his wife, Mary Durrett Vivion, moved from Kentucky to Missouri in 1816. Mahala Vivion was married to Philip Longan in 1825 by Justice of the Peace Jacob Chison. Nancy Vivion Harris, widow of Christopher Harris, married John McDaniel December 11, 1823, with the ceremony performed by David Allee, minister.

John Vivion, their father, was a judge of the first county court of Cole county, with James Stark and Jason Harrison the other two members named by Gove Alexander McNair. He acquired tracts of land in what is now Cole and Monticau counties. Elston, Mo., is now what was once his home place. His heirs sold it to Andrew M. Elston in 1829. A warranty deed in the exchange was signed by the following heirs: Isaiah and Frances Sharp Vivion, Matthew L. and Cynthia V. Pettigrew; Philip and Mahala V. Longan, Charles and Virginia Longan Vivion, Benjamin L. and Lucy V. Clark, James and Frances V. Kenny, John and Nancy V. McDaniel, and Thacker and Polly Vivion.

John, Isaiah and Thacker Vivion were all members of the first grand jury in Cole county. Thacker later moved to Lincoln county. Isaiah's will is recorded in Monticau county.

It is interesting to note that two of the Vivions married two of the Longans, children of John Longan, Baptist minister and justice of the peace, whose will is also recorded in Monticau.

Descendants of John Vivion are now living in Cole, Monticau and Cooper counties, while descendants of his brother, Thomas, are in Boone, Jackson, Audrain and Lafayette counties.

Two Sone Marriages

Two members of the Sone family are also listed in the marriage records, with James Sone and Eliza Peyton being married Feb. 12, 1835, by Judge Tompkins, at the home of her father, William Peyton, three and a half miles southwest of Jefferson City. Both the Sone and Peyton families were among the earliest settlers of Cole county. His father, Michael Sone, was living here as early as 1819, according to records found by his great-grandson, Guy M. Sone, Cole county circuit clerk.

The Sone farm was located three miles south of the city, on the Russellville road, and Michael operated his place as a tavern as early as 1819. He built another home, about 1825 to the north, and this second house still stands. It is located on Sone's creek, west of Jefferson City, and can be seen from Highway 50 West. It is owned today by the Schubert family.

Eliza Peyton came from Peyton Springs, Tenn., to Missouri with her father and sister, Elizabeth Peyton in 1829. Their farm adjoined the Sone property. Her father, William, was the younger brother of Balie Peyton and Joseph Peyton, both congressmen from Tennessee in the early days. Their father, Ephraim Peyton, was a member of the famous Donelson expedition from Virginia to Tennessee in 1779. This expedition has been the subject of a book published in 1944 by Tennessee, entitled "Tennessee During the Revolutionary War." It is called the most important expedition of the revolutionary period.

Mrs. Sone was left a widow in 1855 and continued to live on her farm until 1880 when she moved to Jefferson City and purchased the property at the corner of Dunklin and Washington streets, later owned by Andrew Moerschel. She and her husband are buried in the Rice-Sone cemetery in southern Cole county, and William Peyton's remains were removed to Riverview cemetery from his farm in 1920.

Another member of the Sone family, Elizabeth Sone, and George Gordon were married by Judge Tompkins March 28, 1835. They were the parents of the late Lafayette (Lafe) Gordon, long a prominent real estate broker in Jefferson City, and J. J. Gordon and George Gordon, Jr. Many descendants of this couple live in Jefferson City today and have been among the prominent residents of the county for more than a hundred years.

Nephew of Jefferson

Merriweather Lewis Jefferson and Mary Parson, who were married by the Rev. C. E. Russell October 22, 1840, were both natives of Charlottesville, Va., and it is said that he was a nephew of President Thomas Jefferson.

Mary Parsons was the daughter of Capt. Gustavus A. Parsons and Patience Monroe Parsons who came to Jefferson City in 1837. Their home stood on the first hill east of the governor's mansion and the grounds extended as far south as Capitol avenue. Several homes were built by Capt. Parsons for his children and two of them remain on Jackson street today. It is said that he was employed as a young man by Thomas Jefferson at Monticello as a secretary and the family home was near the Jefferson estate.

Merriweather Lewis Jefferson came here shortly before his marriage to Mary Parsons and resided with her family. Her brother was Gen. Monroe Mosby Parsons of Confederate fame who lost his life on an expedition to Mexico after the Civil War in 1865.

Mrs. Jefferson died in 1842 at the age of 21 and her husband died a few years later. Both are buried in the Woodlawn cemetery on McCarty street in the Parsons family lot and his grave is unmarked.

Charter Members of Church

Charter members of the first Presbyterian church in Jefferson City are also represented in the marriage record, as Dr. Rufus Abbott and Miss Mary Rebecca Hart, whose wedding took place October 21, 1840. She was the daughter of Samuel L. Hart who, with six members of his family and five of his slaves constituted eleven of the thirteen charter members of the first Presbyterian church.

Dr. Rufus Abbott was a young physician who had come to Missouri from Maine. In 1858 the couple moved to Fulton where Dr. Abbott was assistant superintendent of the hospital for the insane. The house which they built at 709 Jefferson street, was called the white court house because of the white columns at the edge of the porch. While the asylum was closed during the Civil War, Dr. Abbott practiced medicine in Callaway county, but returned to his position at the hospital at the close of the war.

Dr. and Mrs. Abbott were the parents of two daughters, Mary and Caroline. Caroline married Elisha Stanley, who lived only a few years. After his death she taught school for many years in Kalamazoo, Mich., and then moved to Washington, D. C., where she began a writing career. She was the author of half a dozen novels and many short stories. Her best-known book, "Order No. 11," based upon that infamous incident of the Civil War, and published in 1904, sold more than 50,000 copies. Mrs. Stanley died about 27 years ago while visiting in the home of her friend, Mrs. Lucy Kerr in Fulton. At that time her son, Lester, a patent attorney in Washington, D. C., and his daughter were the only living descendants of Mary Rebecca Hart and Dr. Abbott.
