





For the purpose of preserving memories of this year at S.H.S., the Echo Staff proudly presents the 1963 annual.





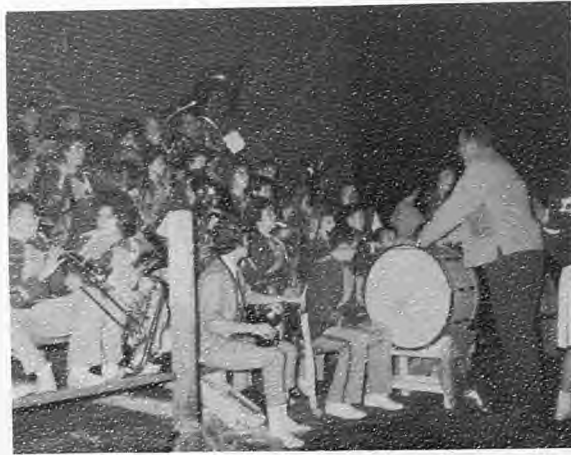

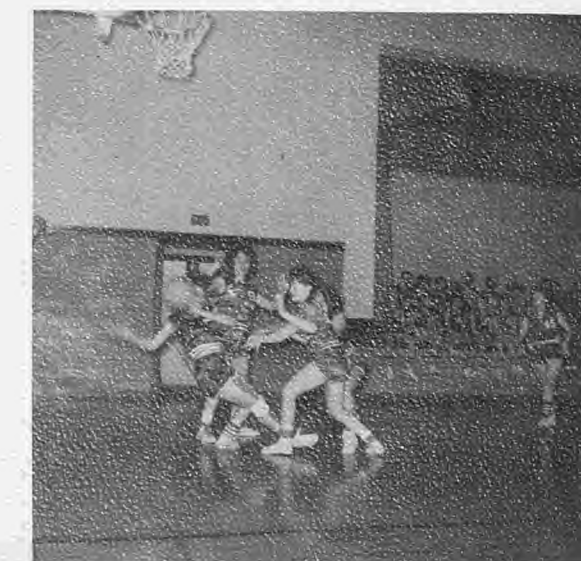

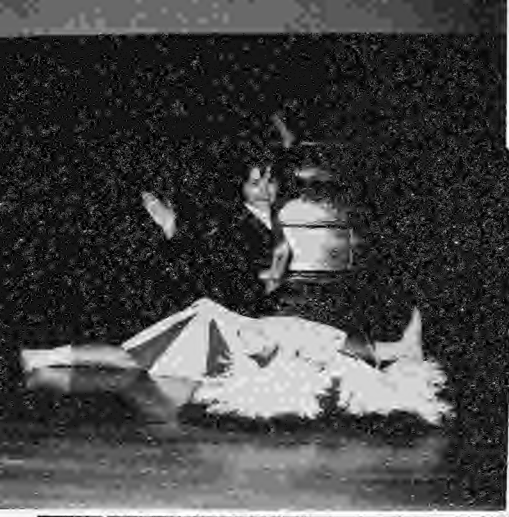
