FRYE

This Pioneer cemetery is located about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile northwest of the town of Mercer, Mercer County, Missouri. It is evident that several graves are here. However, only one marker remains and it has been broken off and lies on the grave. The only other identification is a small foot marker with initials on it.
