Excerpts from the obituary of W. F. King, copied from Hopkins Journal

William Franklin King was born August 13, 1863 near Stanford, In. and passed away at his home in Hopkins, Mo., Nov. 29, 1945, aged 82 years, three months and 27 days.

He was the son of the late James F. and Sarah Nellinger King. At the age of 12 years, Mr. King and his brother, Jake King, who was 17 years old, drove a team and wagon from Indiana to Missouri along with a train of immigrants. They brought their household goods while the remainder of the family came through on the train.

The King family settled on a farm in the Lily White school district, north of Clearmont, Mo. They lived there for one year, then moved to the Sunrise neighborhood north of Maryville, where Mr. King grew to manhood.

On March 4, 1883, he married Emma Buzzard, who survives him. To this union were born four children, Mrs. Delia Baldwin of the home, Harry A. of Maryville, Edgar F., who died July 3, 1943 and a daughter who died in infancy.

In 1900 Mr. and Mrs. King moved southwest of Hopkins where they lived until the spring of 1914, when because of ill health Mr. King was forced to retire and they moved to Hopkins which is the present home.

Mr. King united with the Highland Christian church in 1910, later moving his membership to the Christian church of Hopkins. He was an active church worker and served the local church as superintendent of the Sunday School, as a deacon and as a member of the church board.


He was a member of the IOOF lodge, joining at Pickering in March, 1894. He transferred his membership to Hopkins where he was also a member of the Modern Woodman lodge.

Besides his wife and children he is survived by one brother Andrew H. King of St. Joseph, MO., fifteen grandchildren and twenty-three great grandchildren.

Mr. King was a good neighbor, a kind and understanding father and a tender and thoughtful campanion. He had several long years of suffering but bore his illness with humble patience and endurance.


