Nestled quietly among the trees along a gravel road is the St. Peter's Brush Creek Catholic Church.

St. Peter's Catholic Cemetery Brush Creek



SAINT PETER, the leader of the Apostles, was born at Bethsaida and followed his father's occupation, a fisherman on the sea of Tiberias. The story of his death is related in the apocryphal "Acts of St. Peter". In the purge by Nero after the great fire of Rome (A.D. 64) Peter was sentenced to death by crucifixion and, at his own request, suffered with his head downwards affirming he was unworthy of the posture in which his Master had died.

Similarity of St. Peters-Brush Creek to: St. Pauls-near Center, Mo.

- Share same founder - Fr. Peter Paul Lefevere.
- Twin Churches - Both built in 1860s and Fr. Francis M. Kielty was his own architect for both Churches.
- Both Churches - Named to National Register of Historic Places. St. Pauls-in 1979 and St. Peters-in 1983.
- Same Families - Are buried in both cemeteries. Abell, Bell, Coontz, Elliott, Hagar, Hardy, Little, Shuck, Thomas,- To name a few.

Two Remarkable Priests emerge from this mission parish.

- Fr. Lefevere, the "Patriarch of Northeast Missouri", can be claimed by a few parishes as their founder. And those parishes, that claim another founder, can also, claim that their earlier ancestors had received a timely visit from Fr. Lefevere. Fr. Lefevere baptized a Negro, Mr. Tolton at Brush Creek, who took his name "Peter Paul".
- Fr. Tolton
Peter Paul Tolton, would become the father of Fr. Augustine Tolton, the First Full-Blooded Negro Priest in the USA. Fr. Tolton was baptized at Brush Creek on May 29, 1854 by Fr. John O'Sullivan. In 1976, on October 3rd at a Concelebrated Mass by Bishop Michael F. McAuliffe, a plaque was dedicated honoring Fr. Augustine Tolton.
