From a newspaper clipping found in an old scrapbook: "An Old Man 87 Years

The subject of our sketch is Joseph Crowdis, he was born in Halifax County Virginia March 2nd 1806 where he spent the early part of his life. He was married to Eliza Edwards in 1832 from which union eight children were born: two died in infancy, the remaining six lived to be grown and married with the exception of one daughter who lives with and takes care of the father. In the fall of 1839 he moved to Missouri and settled in Pike County near Spencersburg where he now lives. He has fourteen grandchildren and four grandchildren on the second of March 1893 there was a gathering of his old friends and neighbors and a few of the children. Four of the number present were 60 years and older. The party consisted of his two daughters, Miss Missouri Crowdis and Mrs. Mary A. Lemon, her husband, J. N. Lemon and their four children: Mrs. Sophia Pritchett and her daughter Miss Jennie Pritchett; Mr. and Mrs. Jabe Stewart and their daughter, Miss Sovila Stewart: Mr. William Stewart and Mrs. Cramley. They spent the day very

pleasantly talking of old times and feasting on the good things of which a bountiful supply was prepared by his two daughters, Miss Missouri and Mrs. Lemon, at a later hour they all returned home wishing the old man many more happy birthdays.

"Col. Kutzner (E. A. Kutzner of Scotland Co., Colonel of the third provisional regiment, made up in 1863) at Hannibal was equally objectionable to the people especially those of Confederate sympathies. On the 20th of May, he caused to be arrested and ordered banished to the southern Confederacy a Mrs. Rose and her husband and two young ladies, the Misses Lemon, living near Spencersburg, Ralls Co. The charge against the ladies was that they had given aid and encouragement of the confederate raiders."

The Misses Lemon were Salina and Susan Lemon, and Mrs. Rose was Lucretia Elizabeth Lemon, all daughter of Jacob and Ann (Schooler) Lemon. They spent the years of the War between the states in northern Texas, where Susan married James Crawford.
