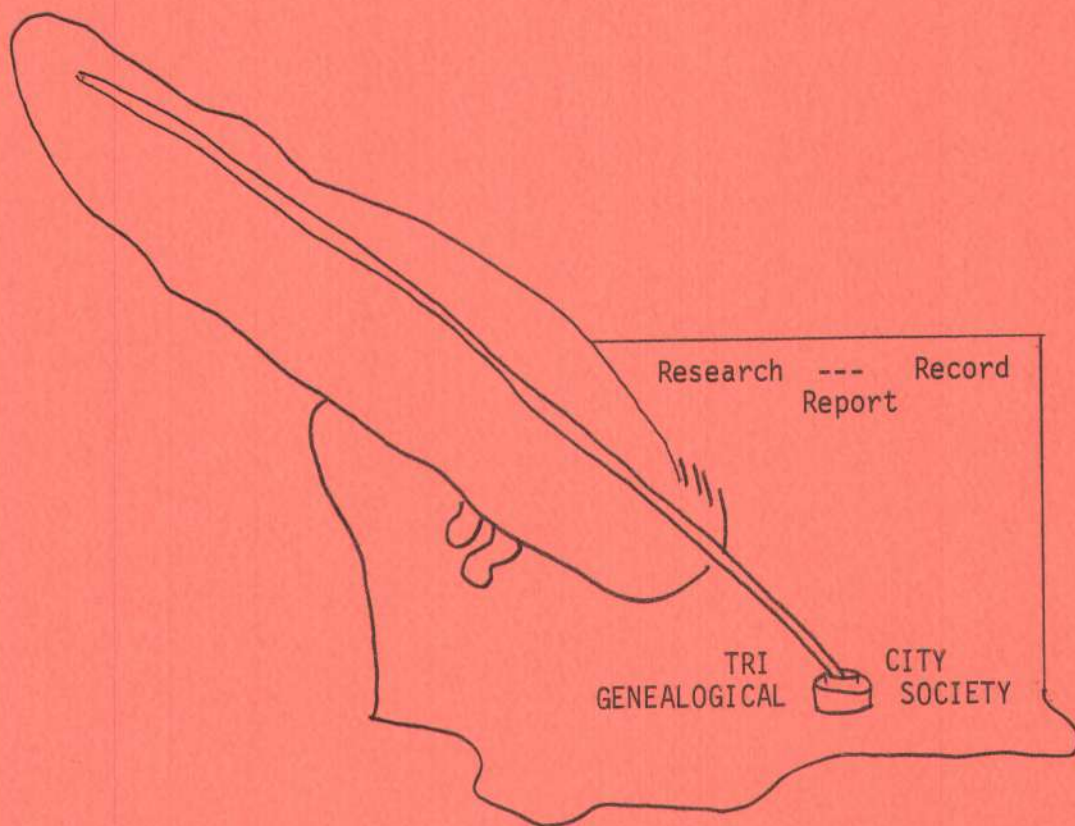

P R E S I D E N T ' S M E S S A G E

The October 16, 1971, Annual Genealogical Workshop for Beginners was our most successful to date, with 33 attending and resulting in 15 new members joining the society. Many thanks to Nadine McClelland, Evelyn Roberts, Harry Wrangham, Dale Denham, Jack and Frances Ehrig, Lorna Shivley, Margaret Rice, Katharine Woolcutt, and Lucille Shaffstall, whose able assistance made the workshop possible.

The November 5th meeting program given by Frances Ehrig was most informative -- its title "Value of State and County Histories and Atlases in Genealogical Research." The By-Law Amendment, Article II, Section 2, passed at this meeting and may now be added to your constitution. It reads as follows:

Section 2. Libraries and Societies shall be titled subscribing memberships and receive the Bulletin only. Individuals from out of the Tri-City area will be entitled to all the benefits of a local member.

The December 3rd meeting program had an active participation of members who attended, posing genealogical problems to our "Problem-Solving Panel", Lyle Perrigo, Evelyn Roberts, and Harry Wrangham. We all benefitted from the answers and discussion.

The January 7, 1972, meeting found us using our long-awaited bound volume of "The Proceedings of the First Symposium on Genealogical and Historical Research Techniques" held March 26 and 27, 1971, by the Seattle Genealogical Society. Katharine Woolcutt reported on "Ancestor Hunting in New England," and Nadine McClelland on "Records Regarding Dependent Children." Remarks: His health has been seriously impaired during the long confinement in Rebel Prisons.

Said Comrade Andrew J. Bloomer served during the War of the Rebellion in the Union Army as Private of Company "J" of the 3rd Regiment Mich Vol. Infty and our records show that he was taken a prisoner of war while in the discharge of his duty near Petersburg VA, on or about the 27th day of October 1865 and that he was confined in the following Southern Military Prisons. Libby, at Richmond, Va. and Salisbury N.C. and finally paroled on the 8th day of March 1865 at Richmond Va.

Given at Chicago, Illinois this Seventh day of April 1882.

C H A N G E S I N T C G S L I B R A R Y G U I D E

Shortly after publication of Tri-Cities Library Guide: Genealogical Holdings of the four libraries in Pasco, Richland, Kennewick, Washington, the L.D.S. Church opened a branch library in Pasco, at 2424 Road 24. Microfilm holdings of the Richland branch were divided, with those rolls paid for by Pasco members going to the new branch. Lon Rigby's collection of English Wills and Probate Records has been moved to Pasco, and so have some of the standard reference books. The Tri-City Genealogical Society's collection remains in Richland.

The following list is of the books and films which have been moved to the Pasco library. It is suggested that those who have purchased the Library Guide go through their copies and mark the items below with some symbol, such as a "P" for Pasco. It is disappointing to go into either library, expecting to use a certain volume, and find it has been moved.

C A R R O L L C E M E T E R Y

Wheeler County, Oregon

Copied by Mr. and Mrs. Daniel S. Christenson. Four generations have been buried here since 1870. This cemetery is located nine and one-half miles northwest of Mitchell OR and is a half mile from the Painted Hills State Park. It is on the north side of the road but can not be seen from the road. It is fenced, fairly well kept up with flowers on the graves. Note: All the markers except those otherwise noted are homemade concrete slabs made by George C. Carroll during the period 1965-1969.

W I L L C H E C K I N D E X

My Story, the autobiography of William Henry Jennings of Louisa County, Iowa, contains many references to events in the lives of others in that age and area. Dale H. Denham, TCGS member who has a copy of the book, is offering to check its index and references for anyone who will send him a stamped, self-addressed envelope. He says:

"The book is written in three chapters -- Early Life, Army Life (Civil War days), and Later Life -- composed of 90 pages. When the occupation or title of an individual was given in the book, that information is included in the index in parentheses.

"William Henry Jennings was born Feb. 14, 1845, in Guernsey County, Ohio, the third son of Benjamin and Ann (Jeffries) Jennings. W. H. Jennings spent most of his early life in Louisa County, Iowa. On Oct. 4, 1870, he was married to Miss Ruth A. Clayton. They had twelve children.

"Mr. Jennings describes his life and companions in an easy-reading style. His life was devoted to his wife and family while engaged in mercantile business, banking, farming, and finally politics. He served two terms in the Nebraska State Senate (1902-1906), representing the 23d Senatorial District."

National Archives and Records Service
Washington, D.C. 20408

The National Archives and Records Service has recently established two time-saving ordering procedures. Researchers requesting reproductions of genealogical records from the National Archives will be billed after the documents are mailed rather than pay in advance.

The National Archives handles a large number of mail orders each day, many of which come from genealogists seeking copies of old military service

files or Federal census schedules. During fiscal 1971 the Central Reference Division received over 120,000 mail requests, mostly for copies of veterans' records or census records, and the volume is expected to increase to 150,000 during fiscal 1972.

The new billing procedure avoids routing incoming mail through a financial office and eliminates refunds necessitated by the high percentage of negative searches. It minimizes handling and paperwork and in turn saves several days' processing time.

Only those requests submitted on the proper forms will be processed. Studies have revealed that much time was lost reading the hundred of long, detailed letters received weekly from genealogists. These letters will now be scanned and if the request is genealogical in nature, the inquirer will be sent a genealogical information kit containing descriptions and ordering forms for genealogical records in the National Archives. The kits and forms for requesting military service and census records are also available from the Central Reference Division (NNC), National Archives and Records Service, Washington, D.C. 20408.

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NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR GENEALOGICAL RESEARCH:

Progress is being made in the concerted effort toward opening vital records for genealogical research. Connecticut has a new law permitting access to members of legally incorporated genealogy societies. The Wisconsin attorney general has ruled that "birth records are public information and there is no reason why the public should be deprived of access to them." A new bill introduced into the Massachusetts General Assembly will 1) allow research by members of a genealogical society regardless of illegitimacy, and 2) free all records over 70 years old.

The National Council (16 Royal Oak Drive, West Hartford CT 06107) is now in the process of acquiring the Vital Statistics Laws from each of the 50 states. George E. Williams, Secretary, says, "We have already received a dozen of them. With these we feel we can advise you personally how to handle the problem of free research in your state. Please ask us for such assistance."
