-- The Read / Reed / Reid / Families of Washington County, Kentucky --  
 by Frances Hansen Ehrig

All records that I have seen, as well as the family tradition, indicate that my great-grandfather George W. Read was born 31 January 1817 in Washington County KY. The family Bible and his tombstone give that date. The Federal Census for Oregon County MO for 1860 (the only one in which I have found George Read) says he was born in Kentucky. Both the application for discharge and the discharge paper itself, from service in the Confederate Army in the Civil War, add the information that he was born in Washington County. (See photocopies following.) His eldest daughter, Mary Elizabeth (Bettie) Read (Mrs. Charles Glenn), told her daughters that he was born in Washington County.

No later records or traditions are available, because George Read was killed by a "bushwhacker" 12 January 1865, and his widow died of consumption on 6 August 1867, so there are no pension records to refer to.

Twenty years of research have failed to produce the names of George's parents, but I have accumulated such a quantity of data on other Read/Reed/Reid families in Washington County KY that I propose to share it through articles in the Tri-City Genealogical Society BULLETIN. I shall welcome correspondence with anyone interested in these families. My address is Route 1, Box 5006, Richland WA 99352.

The logical place to start research seemed to be with the Federal Census of 1820, looking for a family with a son under five years of age. Following are all the Read/Reed/Reid households in Washington County that year. (Hereafter, except when I am quoting from actual records, I shall use the spelling Read to refer to all these families.)

Apparently all of these household except that of the first John Reed would qualify. I went ahead with census reading, intending to check for families in 1830 with sons between 10 and 15. Surprisingly, only one head of household of the right surname appears:

I checked the tax rolls of Washington County KY for 1838, the year George W. Read would have become 21 and required to pay a tax for the first time, but he does not appear. I then checked the tax rolls beginning with the organization

of the county in 1792. A George H. Reed appeared for the first time in 1843, but other evidence eliminated him. The only George W. Reed listed throughout the lifetime of my great-grandfather appeared first on the rolls of 1850. He was taxed for one qualified voter, one white male over 21, and one "horse or mule" at \$40.00. This man appeared repeatedly thereafter and was still being taxed as a resident of Washington County when my George was living and raising a family in Boonville MO.

Following are the taxpayers named Read in Washington County for the first 73 years of its existence. Microfilm was inconsistent in quality, some of it impossible to read. Water courses were used to identify property owned, and in many cases this served to differentiate between two men of the same name.

Realizing that the parents of George W. Read were not necessarily married in Washington County, I nevertheless read all the microfilmed marriage records of the appropriate time period. Legibility of the microfilm was uneven -- some of the older records were clearer than the more recent. Organization was puzzling -- sometimes the index preceded the records, sometimes it followed, sometimes there were two indexes. Applications and returns were listed separately in most cases, but I have combined the information in my notes.

ANOTHER NEW ENGLAND SEMINAR

The New England Historic Genealogical Society will present two in the series of national seminar programs on Family and Local History Research on September 29 in Seattle and on September 30 in Portland. The Seattle program will be in Room 106-B of the University of Washington Student Union, and the Portland one in Room 327 of the Smith Memorial Center, Portland State University.

Lecturers will be James B. Bell, director of the society, and David W. Dumas, authority on the use of legal terms and evidence in genealogical research.

Their morning session, beginning at 9:00, will cover 101 Key Reference Works, and Origins and Uses of First Names and Surnames. In the afternoon they will discuss Wills and Administration, and Compiling and Writing Your Family History.
