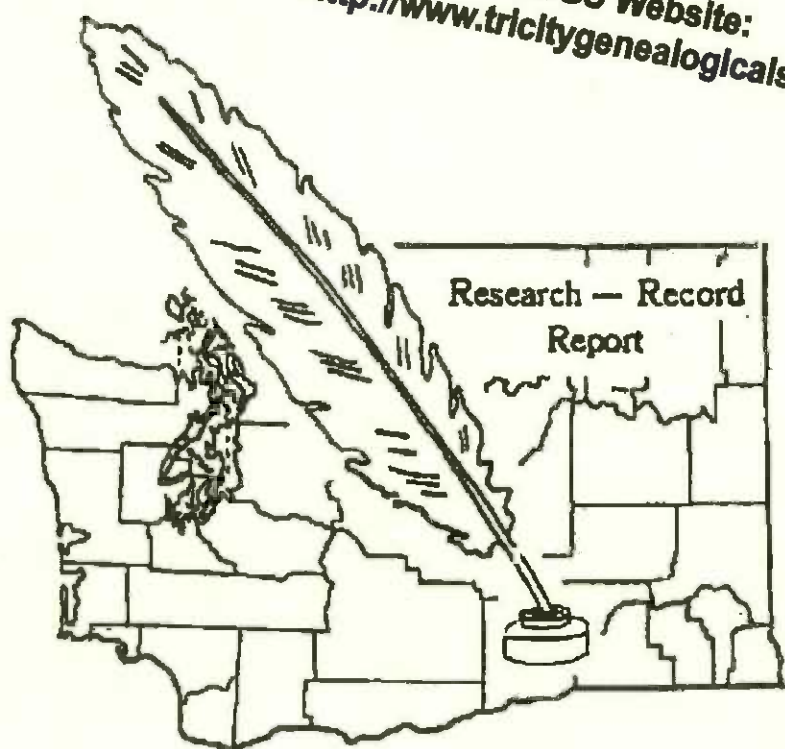

## Tri City Genealogical Society Online Bulletin

### President's Message, John Covey

I wish to congratulate 3 members of our society who were awarded "Outstanding Volunteer" awards by the Washington State Genealogical Society at their annual meeting in Port Angeles. Our recipients are Susan Davis Faulkner (past president), Janet McKinnon (current Vice-president/Program Chair), and Gary Miller.

This year there has been some significant work done by society members in the way of helping preserve records, (the school census project over many years, our bulletins and the 1940 census indexing). For our volunteer work for the school census project we have received a letter and a certification of appreciation (see page 70) from the state. I wish to thank those who spent many hours working on this project.

For the 1940 census indexing project associated with Family Search our group, Tri-City Genealogical Society (Richland, WA) finished up with the following tally: we indexed 83,754 records with 98% accuracy and we arbitrated 154,116 records with a grand total of 237,870 records. With 18 members, the group came in 17th in all the groups [nationwide] with more than 15 members. Thank you to the members of the group and all the other people in the area who worked on this project and helped get the national project done two months ahead of schedule.

For our own preservation of records, the society's bulletins have been located, copied to ensure that there are at least three hard copies, and finally digitized for placing on our web site. This has been and still is a long and involved process. Thank you to the volunteers that have spent many hours working on getting our bulletins preserved.

Helping to preserve records is not the only thing the society does. We have our monthly meetings where people can learn new techniques or about sources and socialize with fellow genealogists. There are classes on genealogy that we help support at the local Family History Centers. So think about [\[See PREZ, next page\]](#)

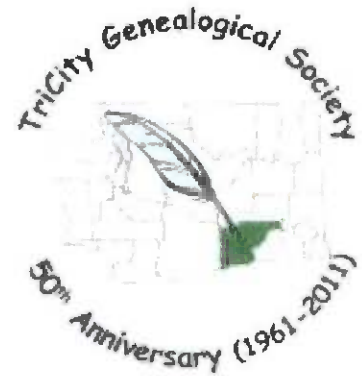

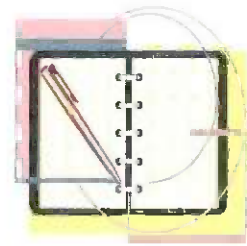

### *Lien's Short Journey to Tri-Cities*

It didn't take a cross-country trip to get me to the Tri-Cities. I came from Portland via Seattle. Both my husband and I were born in Portland. I met him for the first time in 1946 after he returned from the Navy in WW II. He had been in the Navy since his 18<sup>th</sup> birthday in 1943. Nine months after meeting, we were married while he was a college freshman. He went to school on the GI bill and received his degree in civil/structural engineering from the University of Portland. Under the GI Bill, he received \$105/month after he married. I earned \$125 a month working at Meier and Franks Dept. Store. We rented a little house for \$25 a month. TIMES HAVE CHANGED!

After Dex graduated, we bought a small unfinished house on the banks of the Salmon Creek, north of Vancouver, WA. We lived there six years while he worked in Portland. Then his work took us and our first two children to Seattle for eight years. The next move was to the Tri-Cities in 1964. He left in May and I followed as soon as school was out, driving over

with 4 kids, a dog, a cat, a bowl of goldfish, and a turtle.

He went to work for Vitro Engineering and 25 years later retired as Manager of the Civil/Structural Department,

In the early eighties, I joined TCGS and began my ancestor hunt. I took on the challenge of Bulletin Editor for the years 1987-1990. I typed everything on my electric

typewriter and laid the pages out by cutting and pasting (with scissors and glue.) After all the pages were printed, a group of us collated, stapled, addressed and mailed them. What an easy job Lee has.

Since after my first child was born, I've had the privilege of being a domestic engineer (homemaker, that is) for all the rest of my 65 years of marriage, and I don't plan to retire anytime soon.

## *Do you know the way to Richland?*

---

How did I find my way to the Tri-Cities? I have taken the most direct route – the two-lane highway between Spokane and Richland - and I have also taken a very “meandering” route, just as one sees when reading the Family Circus and the various routes those kids take in going from one point to another! I was born and raised in Spokane, Washington. There were a number of times when I came to Richland with my grandmother as she had relatives in the area – the husband was a guard at the Hanford site. I was a pre-teenager at that time and I remember the heat in the Tri-city area in the summer. I remember saying to my grandmother on the way home to Spokane, “who in their right mind would live here – it’s too hot - it’s just a desert down here!”

I graduated from North Central HS (1954) and within one month four of us went to San Diego to attend a two week Navy Reserve Boot camp as we were navy reservists at the time. The first two week obligation was to attend the boot camp then later the two week tours would be sailing on ships. On the way back to Spokane, we agreed to go into the regular Navy that summer. As it turned out, I was the only one that went regular. I completed the 13 week boot camp followed by a 12 week Electricians Mate course in San Diego. I graduated 2<sup>nd</sup> in my class and had some good choices for my duty station. I chose a **Refrigerator Ship named USS Zelima (AF-49)** - a freighter with 5-holds that carried food for replenishing food supplies to ships at sea and our naval bases. This was a very good choice as there were not enough electricians on board to stand watches, really good food – all the time – and I really learned that I enjoyed working with electricity. I had found my PASSION!!

In 1956 following my 2-year tour of duty, I attended Washington State College. I had the GI Bill due to being in the service during the Korean War which paid for 4-years of school, graduating as an Electrical Engineer from Washington State University (the 1<sup>st</sup> class to have that title – (1960).

I met my wife at WSU and we were married between our junior and senior years. She was from Snohomish, Washington and I lived in Seattle during the summer months with my parents. However, on a number of those trips where we would travel from the West side to Pullman, we would travel thru the Tri-Cities. We both had that thought in mind when we passed thru the area, namely, “Who in their right mind would live here?” I had fairly good grades and General Electric hired me. I went on an 18 month training tour with GE as a Field Engineer (we experienced 7 moves in those 18 months). I wound up as the Office Mgr for the Installation and Service Engineering group in Portland, Oregon. After about 18 months I was promoted to my own office located in Eugene, Oregon.



My primary field work would be in the wood industry such as paper mills, plywood mills, and lumber mills with emphasis on control systems. One of my more interesting trips was to La Laja, Chile to work on some control problems on their paper machine making all the computer paper for South America.

After about 3-years in Eugene, I was transferred to the Nuclear Power Generation Department in San Jose – remember the song, “Do you know the way to San Jose?”

My job now was in the Installation & Engineering Department and I was the Instrument & Control representative. I wrote procedures and made field trips to the sites to help the site people get the equipment installed and checked out. I have been to most of the power plants in the US and one trip to the Tokai plant, a sister plant to the Fukushima plant in Japan. As a rep from San Jose, I did make one trip to the Hanford site to review progress. During that visit, the thought came to mind again, “who in their right mind would live here?” Within a short time an opportunity surfaced where a GE Electrical Field Engineer representative was needed at the WPPSS (Washington Public Power Supply System) located in Richland, Washington. (The work at San Jose was starting to create a lot of travel and it was thought it was time to get “BACK HOME TO WASHINGTON”).

In 1979 I was transferred to the Hanford site. I had now made the full circle. One interesting note: when I graduated from WSU, there were 4 or 5 electrical engineers hired by the Hanford site. When I finally arrived on the scene 20 years later they had all left the area and I was the only one from my WSU Electrical

Eng. class now at the Hanford site. I was hired by WPPSS (now Energy Northwest) when the construction cycle was about complete.

My new job would be the Instrument & Control Field Engineer responsible for the equipment inside the containment. At fuel loading time, I became the System Engineer associated with Reactor Recirculation and Feedwater Control systems with

assistance in other control systems.

About three years following the official start-up, I was promoted to the Project Management Group where I was the specialist on control systems. My three big projects involved installing a digital control system for the Recirculation System (the only nuclear plant in the world to have this design) and the Feedwater Control system; and the initial

design and installation of a Core Stability Control System.

We have lived here since 1979 and have learned to LOVE THIS AREA! We do not plan on leaving as OUR ANCHORS have now been dropped.

### **Franklin County, Washington Eighth Grade Examination Results, 1922 – 1936**

**Eighth Grade** exams were a very important part of obtaining a proper education in the 1920s and 1930s. In Franklin County, Washington twelve subjects were tested: Writing, Orthography (Spelling), Arithmetic, Grammar, American History, United States History, Physiology, Geography, Reading, Home Economics, and Manual Training. An average score of 80% or above was necessary to pass and to earn an Eighth Grade Diploma. Tests were administered in the eighth grade, but a majority of students finished their tests a couple of years after starting. RESULTS not listed.
