Kohl Cemetery

The Kohl cemetery is located eight miles west and three and one half miles south of Madison in Kalamazoo Precinct. It is sometimes called the Kalamazoo Cemetery. It is fenced with some nice trees and is well maintained. It was associated with a Methodist Church that was located on the Edward and Margaret (Boysen) Kohl family farm nearby. The church building is long gone, but the cemetery is still active and in fact, in 2000 a gate was added.
